

And she again bare his *brother* Abel. And Abel was a keeper of sheep, but Cain was a tiller of the ground.

Genesis 4:8-11

And Cain talked with Abel his *brother:* and it came to pass, when they were in the field, that Cain rose up against Abel his brother, and slew him. ⁹ And the Lord said unto Cain, Where is Abel thy *brother?* And he said, I know not: Am I my brother's keeper? ¹⁰ And he said, What hast thou done? the voice of thy *brother's* blood crieth unto me from the ground. ¹¹ And now art thou cursed from the earth, which hath opened her mouth to receive thy *brother's* blood from thy hand;

And they took Lot, Abram's *brother's* son, who dwelt in Sodom, and his goods, and departed. ¹³ And there came one that had escaped, and told Abram the Hebrew; for he dwelt in the plain of Mamre the Amorite, *brother* of Eschol, and brother of Aner: and these were confederate with Abram. ¹⁴ And when Abram heard that his *brother* was taken captive, he armed his trained servants, born in his own house, three hundred and eighteen, and pursued them unto Dan.

Genesis 14:16

And he brought back all the goods, and also brought again his *brother* Lot, and his goods, and the women also, and the people.

Genesis 16:12

And he will be a wild man; his hand will be against every man, and every man's hand against him; and he shall dwell in the presence of all his *brethren*.

Genesis 19:7

And said, I pray you, brethren, do not so wickedly.

Genesis 20:5

Said he not unto me, She is my sister? and she, even she herself said, He is my *brother*: in the integrity of my heart and innocency of my hands have I done this.

Genesis 20:13

And it came to pass, when God caused me to wander from my father's house, that I said unto her, This is thy kindness which thou shalt shew unto me; at every place whither we shall come, say of me, He is my *brother*.

Genesis 20:16

And unto Sarah he said, Behold, I have given thy *brother* a thousand pieces of silver: behold, he is to thee a covering of the eyes, unto all that are with thee, and with all other: thus she was reproved.

Genesis 22:20

And it came to pass after these things, that it was told Abraham, saying, Behold, Milcah, she hath also born children unto thy *brother* Nahor;

Genesis 22:21

Huz his firstborn, and Buz his brother, and Kemuel the father of Aram,

Genesis 22:23

And Bethuel begat Rebekah: these eight Milcah did bear to Nahor, Abraham's brother.

Genesis 24:15

And it came to pass, before he had done speaking, that, behold, Rebekah came out, who was born to Bethuel, son of Milcah, the wife of Nahor, Abraham's *brother*, with her pitcher upon her shoulder.

Genesis 24:27

And he said, Blessed be the Lord God of my master Abraham, who hath not left destitute my master of his mercy and his truth: I being in the way, the Lord led me to the house of my master's *brethren*.

Genesis 24:29

And Rebekah had a *brother*, and his name was Laban: and Laban ran out unto the man, unto the well.

Genesis 24:48

And I bowed down my head, and worshipped the Lord, and blessed the Lord God of my master Abraham, which had led me in the right way to take my master's *brother's* daughter unto his son.

Genesis 24:53

And the servant brought forth jewels of silver, and jewels of gold, and raiment, and gave them to Rebekah: he gave also to her *brother* and to her mother precious things.

Genesis 24:55

And her *brother* and her mother said, Let the damsel abide with us a few days, at the least ten; after that she shall go.

Genesis 25:18

And they dwelt from Havilah unto Shur, that is before Egypt, as thou goest toward Assyria: and he died in the presence of all his *brethren*.

Genesis 25:26

And after that came his *brother* out, and his hand took hold on Esau's heel; and his name was called Jacob: and Isaac was threescore years old when she bare them.

Genesis 26:31

And they rose up betimes in the morning, and sware one *to another*: and Isaac sent them away, and they departed from him in peace.

Genesis 27:6

And Rebekah spake unto Jacob her son, saying, Behold, I heard thy father speak unto Esau thy *brother*, saying,

Genesis 27:11

And Jacob said to Rebekah his mother, Behold, Esau my *brother* is a hairy man, and I am a smooth man:

Genesis 27:23

And he discerned him not, because his hands were hairy, as his *brother* Esau's hands: so he blessed him.

Genesis 27:29-30

Let people serve thee, and nations bow down to thee: be lord *over thy brethren*, and let thy mother's sons bow down to thee: cursed be every one that curseth thee, and blessed be he that blesseth thee. ³⁰ And it came to pass, as soon as Isaac had made an end of blessing Jacob, and Jacob was yet scarce gone out from the presence of Isaac his father, that Esau *his brother* came in from his hunting.

Genesis 27:35

And he said, Thy brother came with subtilty, and hath taken away thy blessing.

Genesis 27:37

And Isaac answered and said unto Esau, Behold, I have made him thy lord, and all his *brethren* have I given to him for servants; and with corn and wine have I sustained him: and what shall I do now unto thee, my son?

Genesis 27:40-45

And by thy sword shalt thou live, and shalt serve thy *brother*; and it shall come to pass when thou shalt have the dominion, that thou shalt break his yoke from off thy neck. ⁴¹ And Esau hated Jacob because of the blessing wherewith his father blessed him: and Esau said in his heart, The days of mourning for my father are at hand; then will I slay my *brother* Jacob. ⁴² And these words of Esau her elder son were told to Rebekah: and she sent and called Jacob her younger son, and said unto him, Behold, thy *brother* Esau, as touching thee, doth comfort himself, purposing to kill thee. ⁴³ Now therefore, my son, obey my voice; and arise, flee thou to Laban my *brother* to Haran; ⁴⁴ And tarry with him a few days, until thy *brother's* fury turn away; ⁴⁵ Until thy *brother's* anger turn away from thee, and he forget that which thou hast done to him: then I will send, and fetch thee from thence: why should I be deprived also of you both in one day?

Genesis 28:2

Arise, go to Padan-aram, to the house of Bethuel thy mother's father; and take thee a wife from thence of the daughters of Laban thy mother's *brother*.

Genesis 28:5

And Isaac sent away Jacob: and he went to Padan-aram unto Laban, son of Bethuel the Syrian, the *brother* of Rebekah, Jacob's and Esau's mother.

Genesis 29:4

And Jacob said unto them, My *brethren*, whence be ye? And they said, Of Haran are we.

Genesis 29:10

And it came to pass, when Jacob saw Rachel the daughter of Laban his mother's *brother*, and the sheep of Laban his mother's brother, that Jacob went near, and rolled the stone from the well's mouth, and watered the flock of Laban his mother's *brother*.

Genesis 29:12

And Jacob told Rachel that he was her father's *brother*, and that he was Rebekah's son: and she ran and told her father.

Genesis 29:15

And Laban said unto Jacob, Because thou art my *brother*, shouldest thou therefore serve me for nought? tell me, what shall thy wages be?

Genesis 31:23

And he took his *brethren* with him, and pursued after him seven days' journey; and they overtook him in the mount Gilead.

Genesis 31:25

Then Laban overtook Jacob. Now Jacob had pitched his tent in the mount: and Laban with his *brethren* pitched in the mount of Gilead.

Genesis 31:32

With whomsoever thou findest thy gods, let him not live: before our *brethren* discern thou what is thine with me, and take it to thee. For Jacob knew not that Rachel had stolen them.

Genesis 31:37

Whereas thou hast searched all my stuff, what hast thou found of all thy household stuff? set it here before my *brethren* and thy *brethren*, that they may judge betwixt us both.

Genesis 31:46

And Jacob said unto his *brethren*, Gather stones; and they took stones, and made an heap: and they did eat there upon the heap.

Genesis 31:54

Then Jacob offered sacrifice upon the mount, and called his *brethren* to eat bread: and they did eat bread, and tarried all night in the mount.

Genesis 32:3

And Jacob sent messengers before him to Esau his *brother* unto the land of Seir, the country of Edom.

Genesis 32:6

And the messengers returned to Jacob, saying, We came to thy *brother* Esau, and also he cometh to meet thee, and four hundred men with him.

Genesis 32:11

Deliver me, I pray thee, from the hand of my *brother*, from the hand of Esau: for I fear him, lest he will come and smite me, and the mother with the children.

Genesis 32:13

And he lodged there that same night; and took of that which came to his hand a present for Esau his *brother*;

Genesis 32:17

And he commanded the foremost, saying, When Esau my *brother* meeteth thee, and asketh thee, saying, Whose art thou? and whither goest thou? and whose are these before thee?

Genesis 33:3

And he passed over before them, and bowed himself to the ground seven times, until he came near to his *brother*.

Genesis 33:9

And Esau said, I have enough, my brother; keep that thou hast unto thyself.

Genesis 34:11

And Shechem said unto her father and unto her *brethren,* Let me find grace in your eyes, and what ye shall say unto me I will give.

Genesis 34:25

And it came to pass on the third day, when they were sore, that two of the sons of Jacob, Simeon and Levi, Dinah's *brethren*, took each man his sword, and came upon the city boldly, and slew all the males.

Genesis 35:1

And God said unto Jacob, Arise, go up to Bethel, and dwell there: and make there an altar unto God, that appeared unto thee when thou fleddest from the face of Esau thy *brother*.

Genesis 35:7

And he built there an altar, and called the place El-beth-el: because there God appeared unto him, when he fled from the face of his *brother*.

Genesis 36:6

And Esau took his wives, and his sons, and his daughters, and all the persons of his house, and his cattle, and all his beasts, and all his substance, which he had got in the land of Canaan; and went into the country from the face of his *brother* Jacob.

Genesis 37:2

These are the generations of Jacob. Joseph, being seventeen years old, was feeding the flock with his *brethren*; and the lad was with the sons of Bilhah, and with the sons of Zilpah, his father's wives: and Joseph brought unto his father their evil report.

Genesis 37:4

And when his *brethren* saw that their father loved him more than all his brethren, they hated him, and could not speak peaceably unto him. ⁵ And Joseph dreamed a dream, and he told it his *brethren*: and they hated him yet the more.

Genesis 37:8-14

And his *brethren* said to him, Shalt thou indeed reign over us? or shalt thou indeed have dominion over us? And they hated him yet the more for his dreams, and for his words. ⁹ And he dreamed yet another dream, and told it his *brethren*, and said, Behold, I have dreamed a dream more; and, behold, the sun and the moon and the eleven stars made obeisance to me. ¹⁰ And he told it to his father, and to his *brethren*: and his father rebuked him, and said unto him, What is this dream that thou hast dreamed? Shall I and thy mother and thy *brethren* indeed come to bow down ourselves to thee to the earth? ¹¹ And his *brethren* envied him; but his father observed the saying. ¹² And his *brethren* went to feed their father's flock in Shechem. ¹³ And Israel said unto Joseph, Do not thy *brethren* feed the flock in Shechem? come, and I will send thee unto them. And he said to him, Here am I. ¹⁴ And he said to him, Go, I pray thee, see whether it be well with thy *brethren*, and well with the flocks; and bring me word again. So he sent him out of the vale of Hebron, and he came to Shechem.

Genesis 37:16-17

And he said, I seek my **brethren**: tell me, I pray thee, where they feed their flocks. ¹⁷ And the man said, They are departed hence; for I heard them say, Let us go to Dothan. And Joseph went after his **brethren**, and found them in Dothan.

Genesis 37:19

And they said one to *another*, Behold, this dreamer cometh.

Genesis 37:23

And it came to pass, when Joseph was come unto his *brethren*, that they stript Joseph out of his coat, his coat of many colours that was on him;

Genesis 37:26-27

And Judah said unto his *brethren*, What profit is it if we slay our brother, and conceal his blood? ²⁷ Come, and let us sell him to the Ishmeelites, and let not our hand be upon him; for he is our *brother* and our flesh. And his brethren were content.

Genesis 37:30

And he returned unto his brethren, and said, The child is not; and I, whither shall I go?

Genesis 38:1

And it came to pass at that time, that Judah went down from his *brethren*, and turned in to a certain Adullamite, whose name was Hirah.

Genesis 38:8-9

And Judah said unto Onan, Go in unto thy brother's wife, and marry her, and raise up seed to thy **brother**. ⁹ And Onan knew that the seed should not be his; and it came to pass, when he went in unto his **brother's** wife, that he spilled it on the ground, lest that he should give seed to his brother.

Genesis 38:11

Then said Judah to Tamar his daughter in law, Remain a widow at thy father's house, till Shelah my son be grown: for he said, Lest peradventure he die also, as his *brethren* did. And Tamar went and dwelt in her father's house.

Genesis 38:29

And it came to pass, as he drew back his hand, that, behold, his *brother* came out: and she said, How hast thou broken forth? this breach be upon thee: therefore his name was called Pharez. ³⁰ And afterward came out his *brother*, that had the scarlet thread upon his hand: and his name was called Zarah.

Genesis 42:3-4

And Joseph's ten *brethren* went down to buy corn in Egypt. ⁴ But Benjamin, Joseph's *brother*, Jacob sent not with his brethren; for he said, Lest peradventure mischief befall him.

Genesis 42:6-8

And Joseph was the governor over the land, and he it was that sold to all the people of the land: and Joseph's *brethren* came, and bowed down themselves before him with their faces to the earth. ⁷ And Joseph saw his *brethren*, and he knew them, but made himself strange unto them, and spake roughly unto them; and he said unto them, Whence come ye? And they said, From the land of Canaan to buy food.

⁸ And Joseph knew his *brethren*, but they knew not him.

Genesis 42:13

And they said, Thy servants are twelve *brethren*, the sons of one man in the land of Canaan; and, behold, the youngest is this day with our father, and one is not.

Genesis 42:15-16

Hereby ye shall be proved: By the life of Pharaoh ye shall not go forth hence, except your youngest *brother* come hither. ¹⁶ Send one of you, and let him fetch your *brother*, and ye shall be kept in prison, that your words may be proved, whether there be any truth in you: or else by the life of Pharaoh surely ye are spies.

Genesis 42:19-21

If ye be true men, let one of your *brethren* be bound in the house of your prison: go ye, carry corn for the famine of your houses: ²⁰ But bring your youngest *brother* unto me; so shall your words be verified, and ye shall not die. And they did so. ²¹ And they said one to another, We are verily guilty concerning our *brother*, in that we saw the anguish of his soul, when he besought us, and we would not hear; therefore is this distress come upon us.

Genesis 42:28

And he said unto his *brethren*, My money is restored; and, lo, it is even in my sack: and their heart failed them, and they were afraid, saying one to another, What is this that God hath done unto us?

Genesis 42:32

We be twelve *brethren*, sons of our father; one is not, and the youngest is this day with our father in the land of Canaan. ³³ And the man, the lord of the country, said unto us, Hereby shall I know that ye are true men; leave one of your *brethren* here with me, and take food for the famine of your households, and be gone: ³⁴ And bring your youngest *brother* unto me: then shall I know that ye are no spies, but that ye are true men: so will I deliver you your brother, and ye shall traffick in the land.

Genesis 42:38

And he said, My son shall not go down with you; for his *brother* is dead, and he is left alone: if mischief befall him by the way in the which ye go, then shall ye bring down my gray hairs with sorrow to the grave.

Genesis 43:3-7

And Judah spake unto him, saying, The man did solemnly protest unto us, saying, Ye shall not see my face, except your *brother* be with you. ⁴ If thou wilt send our *brother* with us, we will go down and buy thee food: ⁵ But if thou wilt not send him, we will not go down: for the man said unto us, Ye shall not see my face, except your *brother* be with you. ⁶ And Israel said, Wherefore dealt ye so ill with me, as to tell the man whether ye had yet a *brother*? ⁷ And they said, The man asked us straitly of our state, and of our kindred, saying, Is your father yet alive? have ye another *brother*? and we told him according to the tenor of these words: could we certainly know that he would say, Bring your *brother* down?

Genesis 43:13-14

Take also your *brother,* and arise, go again unto the man: ¹⁴ And God Almighty give you mercy before the man, that he may send away your other *brother*, and Benjamin. If I be bereaved of my children, I am bereaved.

Genesis 43:29-30

And he lifted up his eyes, and saw his brother Benjamin, his mother's son, and said, Is this your younger *brother*, of whom ye spake unto me? And he said, God be gracious unto thee, my son. ³⁰ And Joseph made haste; for his bowels did yearn upon his *brother*: and he sought where to weep; and he entered into his chamber, and wept there.

Genesis 44:14

And Judah and his *brethren* came to Joseph's house; for he was yet there: and they fell before him on the ground.

Genesis 44:19-20

My lord asked his servants, saying, Have ye a father, or a *brother*? ²⁰ And we said unto my lord, We have a father, an old man, and a child of his old age, a little one; and his *brother* is dead, and he alone is left of his mother, and his father loveth him.

Genesis 44:23

And thou saidst unto thy servants, Except your youngest *brother* come down with you, ye shall see my face no more.

Genesis 44:26

And we said, We cannot go down: if our youngest *brother* be with us, then will we go down: for we may not see the man's face, except our youngest brother be with us.

Genesis 44:33

Now therefore, I pray thee, let thy servant abide instead of the lad a bondman to my lord; and let the lad go up with his *brethren*.

Genesis 45:1

Then Joseph could not refrain himself before all them that stood by him; and he cried, Cause every man to go out from me. And there stood no man with him, while Joseph made himself known unto his *brethren*.

Genesis 45:3-4

And Joseph said unto his *brethren*, I am Joseph; doth my father yet live? And his brethren could not answer him; for they were troubled at his presence. ⁴ And Joseph said unto his *brethren*, Come near to me, I pray you. And they came near. And he said, I am Joseph your brother, whom ye sold into Egypt.

Genesis 45:12

And, behold, your eyes see, and the eyes of my *brother* Benjamin, that it is my mouth that speaketh unto you.

Genesis 45:14-17

And he fell upon his *brother* Benjamin's neck, and wept; and Benjamin wept upon his neck. ¹⁵ Moreover he kissed all his *brethren*, and wept upon them: and after that his brethren talked with him. ¹⁶ And the fame thereof was heard in Pharaoh's house, saying, Joseph's *brethren* are come: and it pleased Pharaoh well, and his servants. ¹⁷ And Pharaoh said unto Joseph, Say unto thy *brethren*, This do ye; lade your beasts, and go, get you unto the land of Canaan;

Genesis 45:24

So he sent his *brethren* away, and they departed: and he said unto them, See that ye fall not out by the way.

Genesis 46:31

And Joseph said unto his *brethren*, and unto his father's house, I will go up, and shew Pharaoh, and say unto him, My *brethren*, and my father's house, which were in the land of Canaan, are come unto me;

Genesis 47:1-3

Then Joseph came and told Pharaoh, and said, My father and my *brethren*, and their flocks, and their herds, and all that they have, are come out of the land of Canaan; and, behold, they are in the land of Goshen. ² And he took some of his *brethren*, even five men, and presented them unto Pharaoh. ³ And Pharaoh said unto his *brethren*, What is your occupation? And they said unto Pharaoh, Thy servants are shepherds, both we, and also our fathers.

Genesis 47:5-6

And Pharaoh spake unto Joseph, saying, Thy father and thy *brethren* are come unto thee: ⁶ The land of Egypt is before thee; in the best of the land make thy father and *brethren* to dwell; in the land of Goshen let them dwell: and if thou knowest any men of activity among them, then make them rulers over my cattle.

Genesis 47:11-12

And Joseph placed his father and his *brethren*, and gave them a possession in the land of Egypt, in the best of the land, in the land of Rameses, as Pharaoh had commanded. ¹² And Joseph nourished his father, and his *brethren*, and all his father's household, with bread, according to their families.

Genesis 48:6

And thy issue, which thou begettest after them, shall be thine, and shall be called after the name of their *brethren* in their inheritance.

Genesis 48:19

And his father refused, and said, I know it, my son, I know it: he also shall become a people, and he also shall be great: but truly his younger *brother* shall be greater than he, and his seed shall become a multitude of nations.

Genesis 48:22

Moreover I have given to thee one portion above thy *brethren*, which I took out of the hand of the Amorite with my sword and with my bow.

Genesis 49:5

Simeon and Levi are *brethren*; instruments of cruelty are in their habitations.

Genesis 49:8

Judah, thou art he whom thy *brethren* shall praise: thy hand shall be in the neck of thine enemies; thy father's children shall bow down before thee.

Genesis 49:26

The blessings of thy father have prevailed above the blessings of my progenitors unto the utmost bound of the everlasting hills: they shall be on the head of Joseph, and on the crown of the head of him that was separate from his *brethren*.

Genesis 50:8

And all the house of Joseph, and his *brethren*, and his father's house: only their little ones, and their flocks, and their herds, they left in the land of Goshen.

Genesis 50:14-15

And Joseph returned into Egypt, he, and his *brethren*, and all that went up with him to bury his father, after he had buried his father. ¹⁵ And when Joseph's *brethren* saw that their father was dead, they said, Joseph will peradventure hate us, and will certainly requite us all the evil which we did unto him.

Genesis 50:17-18

So shall ye say unto Joseph, Forgive, I pray thee now, the trespass of thy *brethren*, and their sin; for they did unto thee evil: and now, we pray thee, forgive the trespass of the servants of the God of thy father. And Joseph wept when they spake unto him.

18 And his *brethren* also went and fell down before his face; and they said, Behold, we be thy servants.

Genesis 50:24

And Joseph said unto his *brethren*, I die: and God will surely visit you, and bring you out of this land unto the land which he sware to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob.

Exodus 1:6

And Joseph died, and all his *brethren*, and all that generation.

Exodus 2:11

And it came to pass in those days, when Moses was grown, that he went out unto his brethren, and looked on their burdens: and he spied an Egyptian smiting an Hebrew, one of his *brethren*.

Exodus 4:14

And the anger of the Lord was kindled against Moses, and he said, Is not Aaron the Levite thy *brother*? I know that he can speak well. And also, behold, he cometh forth to meet thee: and when he seeth thee, he will be glad in his heart.

Exodus 4:18

And Moses went and returned to Jethro his father in law, and said unto him, Let me go, I pray thee, and return unto my *brethren* which are in Egypt, and see whether they be yet alive. And Jethro said to Moses, Go in peace.

Exodus 7:1-2

And the Lord said unto Moses, See, I have made thee a god to Pharaoh: and Aaron thy *brother* shall be thy prophet. ² Thou shalt speak all that I command thee: and Aaron thy *brother* shall speak unto Pharaoh, that he send the children of Israel out of his land.

Exodus 10:23

They saw not one *another*, neither rose any from his place for three days: but all the children of Israel had light in their dwellings.

Exodus 16:15

And when the children of Israel saw it, they said one to *another*, It is manna: for they wist not what it was. And Moses said unto them, This is the bread which the Lord hath given you to eat.

Exodus 25:20

And the cherubims shall stretch forth their wings on high, covering the mercy seat with their wings, and their faces shall look one to *another*; toward the mercy seat shall the faces of the cherubims be.

Exodus 28:1-2

And take thou unto thee Aaron thy **brother**, and his sons with him, from among the children of Israel, that he may minister unto me in the priest's office, even Aaron, Nadab and Abihu, Eleazar and Ithamar, Aaron's sons. ² And thou shalt make holy garments for Aaron thy **brother** for glory and for beauty.

Exodus 28:4

And these are the garments which they shall make; a breastplate, and an ephod, and a robe, and a broidered coat, a mitre, and a girdle: and they shall make holy garments for Aaron thy *brother*, and his sons, that he may minister unto me in the priest's office.

Exodus 28:41

And thou shalt put them upon Aaron thy *brother,* and his sons with him; and shalt anoint them, and consecrate them, and sanctify them, that they may minister unto me in the priest's office.

Exodus 32:27

And he said unto them, Thus saith the Lord God of Israel, Put every man his sword by his side, and go in and out from gate to gate throughout the camp, and slay every man his *brother*, and every man his companion, and every man his neighbour.

Exodus 32:29

For Moses had said, Consecrate yourselves to day to the Lord, even every man upon his son, and upon his *brother;* that he may bestow upon you a blessing this day.

Exodus 37:9

And the cherubims spread out their wings on high, and covered with their wings over the mercy seat, with their faces one to *another*; even to the mercy seatward were the faces of the cherubims.

Leviticus 7:10

And every meat offering, mingled with oil, and dry, shall all the sons of Aaron have, one as much *as another*.

Leviticus 10:4

And Moses called Mishael and Elzaphan, the sons of Uzziel the uncle of Aaron, and said unto them, Come near, carry your *brethren* from before the sanctuary out of the camp.

Leviticus 10:6

And Moses said unto Aaron, and unto Eleazar and unto Ithamar, his sons, Uncover not your heads, neither rend your clothes; lest ye die, and lest wrath come upon all the people: but let your *brethren*, the whole house of Israel, bewail the burning which the Lord hath kindled.

Leviticus 16:2

And the Lord said unto Moses, Speak unto Aaron thy *brother*, that he come not at all times into the holy place within the vail before the mercy seat, which is upon the ark; that he die not: for I will appear in the cloud upon the mercy seat.

Leviticus 18:14

Thou shalt not uncover the nakedness of thy father's *brother*, thou shalt not approach to his wife: she is thine aunt.

Leviticus 18:16-17

Thou shalt not uncover the nakedness of thy *brother's* wife: it is thy brother's nakedness. ¹⁷ Thou shalt not hate thy *brother* in thine heart: thou shalt in any wise rebuke thy neighbour, and not suffer sin upon him.

Leviticus 20:21

And if a man shall take his *brother's* wife, it is an unclean thing: he hath uncovered his brother's nakedness; they shall be childless.

Leviticus 21:2

But for his kin, that is near unto him, that is, for his mother, and for his father, and for his son, and for his daughter, and for his *brother*,

Leviticus 21:10

And he that is the high priest among his *brethren,* upon whose head the anointing oil was poured, and that is consecrated to put on the garments, shall not uncover his head, nor rend his clothes;

Leviticus 25:14

And if thou sell ought unto thy neighbour, or buyest ought of thy neighbour's hand, ye shall not oppress one *another:*

Leviticus 25:25

If thy brother be waxen poor, and hath sold away some of his possession, and if any of his kin come to redeem it, then shall he redeem that which his *brother* sold.

Leviticus 25:35-36

And if thy *brother* be waxen poor, and fallen in decay with thee; then thou shalt relieve him: yea, though he be a stranger, or a sojourner; that he may live with thee. ³⁶ Take thou no usury of him, or increase: but fear thy God; that thy *brother* may live with thee.

Leviticus 25:39

And if thy *brother* that dwelleth by thee be waxen poor, and be sold unto thee; thou shalt not compel him to serve as a bondservant:

Leviticus 25:46-48

And ye shall take them as an inheritance for your children after you, to inherit them for a possession; they shall be your bondmen for ever: but over your *brethren* the children of Israel, ye shall not rule one over another with rigour. ⁴⁷ And if a sojourner or stranger wax rich by thee, and thy *brother* that dwelleth by him wax poor, and sell himself unto the stranger or sojourner by thee, or to the stock of the stranger's family: ⁴⁸ After that he is sold he may be redeemed again; one of his *brethren* may redeem him:

Leviticus 26:37

And they shall fall one upon *another*, as it were before a sword, when none pursueth: and ye shall have no power to stand before your enemies.

Numbers 6:7

He shall not make himself unclean for his father, or for his mother, for his *brother*, or for his sister, when they die: because the consecration of his God is upon his head.

Numbers 8:26

But shall minister with their *brethren* in the tabernacle of the congregation, to keep the charge, and shall do no service. Thus shalt thou do unto the Levites touching their charge.

Numbers 14:4

And they said one to another, Let us make a captain, and let us return into Egypt.

Numbers 16:10

And he hath brought thee near to him, and all thy *brethren* the sons of Levi with thee: and seek ye the priesthood also?

Numbers 18:2

And thy *brethren* also of the tribe of Levi, the tribe of thy father, bring thou with thee, that they may be joined unto thee, and minister unto thee: but thou and thy sons with thee shall minister before the tabernacle of witness.

Numbers 18:6

And I, behold, I have taken your *brethren* the Levites from among the children of Israel: to you they are given as a gift for the Lord, to do the service of the tabernacle of the congregation.

Numbers 20:3

And the people chode with Moses, and spake, saying, Would God that we had died when our *brethren* died before the Lord!

Numbers 20:8

Take the rod, and gather thou the assembly together, thou, and Aaron thy **brother**, and speak ye unto the rock before their eyes; and it shall give forth his water, and thou shalt bring forth to them water out of the rock: so thou shalt give the congregation and their beasts drink.

Numbers 20:14

And Moses sent messengers from Kadesh unto the king of Edom, Thus saith thy *brother* Israel, Thou knowest all the travail that hath befallen us:

Numbers 25:6

And, behold, one of the children of Israel came and brought unto his *brethren* a Midianitish woman in the sight of Moses, and in the sight of all the congregation of the children of Israel, who were weeping before the door of the tabernacle of the congregation.

Numbers 27:4

Why should the name of our father be done away from among his family, because he hath no son? Give unto us therefore a possession among the *brethren* of our father.

Numbers 27:7

The daughters of Zelophehad speak right: thou shalt surely give them a possession of an inheritance among their father's *brethren*; and thou shalt cause the inheritance of their father to pass unto them.

Numbers 27:9-11

And if he have no daughter, then ye shall give his inheritance unto his **brethren**. 10 And if he have no **brethren**, then ye shall give his inheritance unto his father's brethren. 11 And if his father have no **brethren**, then ye shall give his inheritance unto his kinsman that is next to him of his family, and he shall possess it: and it shall be unto the children of Israel a statute of judgment, as the Lord commanded Moses.

Numbers 27:13

And when thou hast seen it, thou also shalt be gathered unto thy people, as Aaron thy *brother* was gathered.

Numbers 32:6

And Moses said unto the children of Gad and to the children of Reuben, Shall your *brethren* go to war, and shall ye sit here?

Numbers 36:2

And they said, The Lord commanded my lord to give the land for an inheritance by lot to the children of Israel: and my lord was commanded by the Lord to give the inheritance of Zelophehad our *brother* unto his daughters.

Deuteronomy 1:16

And I charged your judges at that time, saying, Hear the causes between your *brethren*, and judge righteously between every man and his brother, and the stranger that is with him.

Deuteronomy 1:28

Whither shall we go up? our *brethren* have discouraged our heart, saying, The people is greater and taller than we; the cities are great and walled up to heaven; and moreover we have seen the sons of the Anakims there.

Deuteronomy 2:4

And command thou the people, saying, Ye are to pass through the coast of your *brethren* the children of Esau, which dwell in Seir; and they shall be afraid of you: take ye good heed unto yourselves therefore:

Deuteronomy 2:8

And when we passed by from our *brethren* the children of Esau, which dwelt in Seir, through the way of the plain from Elath, and from Ezion-gaber, we turned and passed by the way of the wilderness of Moab.

Deuteronomy 3:18

And I commanded you at that time, saying, The Lord your God hath given you this land to possess it: ye shall pass over armed before your *brethren* the children of Israel, all that are meet for the war.

Deuteronomy 3:20

Until the Lord have given rest unto your *brethren*, as well as unto you, and until they also possess the land which the Lord your God hath given them beyond Jordan: and then shall ye return every man unto his possession, which I have given you.

Deuteronomy 10:9

Wherefore Levi hath no part nor inheritance with his *brethren*; the Lord is his inheritance, according as the Lord thy God promised him.

Deuteronomy 13:6

If thy *brother*, the son of thy mother, or thy son, or thy daughter, or the wife of thy bosom, or thy friend, which is as thine own soul, entice thee secretly, saying, Let us go and serve other gods, which thou hast not known, thou, nor thy fathers;

Deuteronomy 15:2-3

And this is the manner of the release: Every creditor that lendeth ought unto his neighbour shall release it; he shall not exact it of his neighbour, or of his *brother;* because it is called the Lord's release. ³ Of a foreigner thou mayest exact it again: but that which is thine with thy *brother* thine hand shall release;

Deuteronomy 15:7

If there be among you a poor man of one of thy *brethren* within any of thy gates in thy land which the Lord thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not harden thine heart, nor shut thine hand from thy poor brother:

Deuteronomy 15:9

Beware that there be not a thought in thy wicked heart, saying, The seventh year, the year of release, is at hand; and thine eye be evil against thy poor *brother*, and thou givest him nought; and he cry unto the Lord against thee, and it be sin unto thee.

Deuteronomy 15:11-12

For the poor shall never cease out of the land: therefore I command thee, saying, Thou shalt open thine hand wide unto thy *brother*, to thy poor, and to thy needy, in thy land. ¹² And if thy *brother*, an Hebrew man, or an Hebrew woman, be sold unto thee, and serve thee six years; then in the seventh year thou shalt let him go free from thee.

Deuteronomy 17:15

Thou shalt in any wise set him king over thee, whom the Lord thy God shall choose: one from among thy *brethren* shalt thou set king over thee: thou mayest not set a stranger over thee, which is not thy *brother*.

Deuteronomy 17:20

That his heart be not lifted up above his *brethren*, and that he turn not aside from the commandment, to the right hand, or to the left: to the end that he may prolong his days in his kingdom, he, and his children, in the midst of Israel.

Deuteronomy 18:2

Therefore shall they have no inheritance among their *brethren*: the Lord is their inheritance, as he hath said unto them.

Deuteronomy 18:7

Then he shall minister in the name of the Lord his God, as all his *brethren* the Levites do, which stand there before the Lord.

Deuteronomy 18:15

The Lord thy God will raise up unto thee a Prophet from the midst of thee, of thy *brethren*, like unto me; unto him ye shall hearken;

Deuteronomy 18:18

I will raise them up a Prophet from among their *brethren*, like unto thee, and will put my words in his mouth; and he shall speak unto them all that I shall command him.

Deuteronomy 19:18-19

And the judges shall make diligent inquisition: and, behold, if the witness be a false witness, and hath testified falsely against his *brother*; ¹⁹ Then shall ye do unto him, as he had thought to have done unto his *brother*: so shalt thou put the evil away from among you.

Deuteronomy 20:8

And the officers shall speak further unto the people, and they shall say, What man is there that is fearful and fainthearted? let him go and return unto his house, lest his *brethren's* heart faint as well as his heart.

Deuteronomy 22:1-4

Thou shalt not see the *brother's* ox or his sheep go astray, and hide thyself from them: thou shalt in any case bring them again unto thy *brother*. ² And if thy *brother* be not nigh unto thee, or if thou know him not, then thou shalt bring it unto thine own house, and it shall be with thee until thy *brother* seek after it, and thou shalt restore it to him again. ³ In like manner shalt thou do with his ass; and so shalt thou do with his raiment; and with all lost thing of thy *brother's*, which he hath lost, and thou hast found, shalt thou do likewise: thou mayest not hide thyself. ⁴ Thou shalt not see thy *brother's* ass or his ox fall down by the way, and hide thyself from them: thou shalt surely help him to lift them up again.

Deuteronomy 23:7

Thou shalt not abhor an Edomite; for he is thy *brother*: thou shalt not abhor an Egyptian; because thou wast a stranger in his land.

Deuteronomy 23:19-20

Thou shalt not lend upon usury to thy *brother*; usury of money, usury of victuals, usury of any thing that is lent upon usury: ²⁰ Unto a stranger thou mayest lend upon usury; but unto thy *brother* thou shalt not lend upon usury: that the Lord thy God may bless thee in all that thou settest thine hand to in the land whither thou goest to possess it.

Deuteronomy 24:7

If a man be found stealing any of his *brethren* of the children of Israel, and maketh merchandise of him, or selleth him; then that thief shall die; and thou shalt put evil away from among you.

Deuteronomy 24:14

Thou shalt not oppress an hired servant that is poor and needy, whether he be of thy *brethren*, or of thy strangers that are in thy land within thy gates:

Deuteronomy 25:3

Forty stripes he may give him, and not exceed: lest, if he should exceed, and beat him above these with many stripes, then thy *brother* should seem vile unto thee.

Deuteronomy 25:5-7

If **brethren** dwell together, and one of them die, and have no child, the wife of the dead shall not marry without unto a stranger: her husband's brother shall go in unto her, and take her to him to wife, and perform the duty of an husband's brother unto her. ⁶ And it shall be, that the firstborn which she beareth shall succeed in the name of **his brother** which is dead, that his name be not put out of Israel. ⁷ And if the man like not to take his brother's wife, then let his brother's wife go up to the gate unto the elders, and say, My

husband's brother refuseth to raise up *unto his brother* a name in Israel, he will not perform the duty of my husband's brother.

Deuteronomy 25:9

Then shall his brother's wife come unto him in the presence of the elders, and loose his shoe from off his foot, and spit in his face, and shall answer and say, So shall it be done unto that man that will not build up *his brother's* house.

Deuteronomy 25:11

When men strive together one *with another*, and the wife of the one draweth near for to deliver her husband out of the hand of him that smitch him, and putteth forth her hand, and taketh him by the secrets:

Deuteronomy 28:54

So that the man that is tender among you, and very delicate, his eye shall be evil toward his *brother*, and toward the wife of his bosom, and toward the remnant of his children which he shall leave:

Deuteronomy 32:50

And die in the mount whither thou goest up, and be gathered unto thy people; as Aaron thy *brother* died in mount Hor, and was gathered unto his people:

Deuteronomy 33:9

Who said unto his father and to his mother, I have not seen him; neither did he acknowledge his *brethren*, nor knew his own children: for they have observed thy word, and kept thy covenant.

Deuteronomy 33:16

And for the precious things of the earth and fulness thereof, and for the good will of him that dwelt in the bush: let the blessing come upon the head of Joseph, and upon the top of the head of him that was separated from his *brethren*.

Deuteronomy 33:24

And of Asher he said, Let Asher be blessed with children; let him be acceptable to his *brethren*, and let him dip his foot in oil.

Joshua 1:14-15

Your wives, your little ones, and your cattle, shall remain in the land which Moses gave you on this side Jordan; but ye shall pass before *your brethren* armed, all the mighty men of valour, and help them; ¹⁵ Until the LORD have given *your brethren* rest, as he hath given you, and they also have possessed the land which the LORD your God giveth them: then ye shall return unto the land of your possession, and enjoy it, which Moses the LORD 's servant gave you on this side Jordan toward the sunrising.

Joshua 2:13

And that ye will save alive my father, and my mother, and my *brethren*, and my sisters, and all that they have, and deliver our lives from death.

Joshua 2:18

Behold, when we come into the land, thou shalt bind this line of scarlet thread in the window which thou didst let us down by: and thou shalt bring thy father, and thy mother, and thy *brethren*, and all thy father's household, home unto thee.

Joshua 6:23

And the young men that were spies went in, and brought Rahab, and her father, and her mother, and her *brethren*, and all that she had; and they brought out all her kindred, and left them without the camp of Israel.

Joshua 14:8

Nevertheless my *brethren* that went up with me made the heart of the people melt: but I wholly followed the Lord my God.

Joshua 15:17

And Othniel the son of Kenaz, the *brother* of Caleb, took it: and he gave him Achsah his daughter to wife.

Joshua 17:4

And they came near before Eleazar the priest, and before Joshua the son of Nun, and before the princes, saying, The Lord commanded Moses to give us an inheritance among *our brethren.* Therefore according to the commandment of the Lord he gave them an inheritance among *the brethren* of their father.

Joshua 22:3-4

Ye have not left your *brethren* these many days unto this day, but have kept the charge of the commandment of the Lord your God. ⁴ And now the Lord your God hath given rest unto your *brethren*, as he promised them: therefore now return ye, and get you unto your tents, and unto the land of your possession, which Moses the servant of the Lord gave you on the other side Jordan.

Joshua 22:7-8

Now to the one half of the tribe of Manasseh Moses had given possession in Bashan: but unto the other half thereof gave Joshua among their *brethren* on this side Jordan westward. And when Joshua sent them away also unto their tents, then he blessed them, ⁸ And he spake unto them, saying, Return with much riches unto your tents, and with very much cattle, with silver, and with gold, and with brass, and with iron, and with very much raiment: divide the spoil of your enemies with your *brethren*.

Judges 1:3

And Judah said unto Simeon his *brother*, Come up with me into my lot, that we may fight against the Canaanites; and I likewise will go with thee into thy lot. So Simeon went with him.

Judges 1:13

And Othniel the son of Kenaz, Caleb's younger *brother*, took it: and he gave him Achsah his daughter to wife.

Judges 1:17

And Judah went with Simeon his *brother*, and they slew the Canaanites that inhabited Zephath, and utterly destroyed it. And the name of the city was called Hormah.

Judges 3:9

And when the children of Israel cried unto the Lord, the Lord raised up a deliverer to the children of Israel, who delivered them, even Othniel the son of Kenaz, Caleb's younger *brother.*

Judges 8:19

And he said, They were my *brethren*, even the sons of my mother: as the Lord liveth, if ye had saved them alive, I would not slay you.

Judges 9:1

And Abimelech the son of Jerubbaal went to Shechem unto his mother's *brethren*, and communed with them, and with all the family of the house of his mother's father, saying,

Judges 9:3

And his mother's *brethren* spake of him in the ears of all the men of Shechem all these words: and their hearts inclined to follow Abimelech; for they said, He is our

Judges 9:5

And he went unto his father's house at Ophrah, and slew his *brethren* the sons of Jerubbaal, being threescore and ten persons, upon one stone: notwithstanding yet Jotham the youngest son of Jerubbaal was left; for he hid himself.

Judges 9:18

And ye are risen up against my father's house this day, and have slain his sons, threescore and ten persons, upon one stone, and have made Abimelech, the son of his maidservant, king over the men of Shechem, because he is your *brother*;)

Judges 9:21

And Jotham ran away, and fled, and went to Beer, and dwelt there, for fear of Abimelech his *brother*.

Judges 9:24

That the cruelty done to the threescore and ten sons of Jerubbaal might come, and their blood be laid upon Abimelech *their brother*, which slew them; and upon the men of Shechem, which aided him in the killing of *his brethren*.

Judges 9:26

And Gaal the son of Ebed came with *his brethren*, and went over to Shechem: and the men of Shechem put their confidence in him.

Judges 9:31

And he sent messengers unto Abimelech privily, saying, Behold, Gaal the son of Ebed and *his brethren* be come to Shechem; and, behold, they fortify the city against thee.

Judges 9:41

And Abimelech dwelt at Arumah: and Zebul thrust out Gaal and *his brethren*, that they should not dwell in Shechem.

Judges 9:56

Thus God rendered the wickedness of Abimelech, which he did unto his father, in slaying *his* seventy *brethren:*

Judges 11:3

Then Jephthah fled from *his brethren*, and dwelt in the land of Tob: and there were gathered vain men to Jephthah, and went out with him.

Judges 14:3

Then his father and his mother said unto him, Is there never a woman among the daughters of *thy brethren*, or among all my people, that thou goest to take a wife of the uncircumcised Philistines? And Samson said unto his father, Get her for me; for she pleaseth me well.

Judges 16:31

Then *his brethren* and all the house of his father came down, and took him, and brought him up, and buried him between Zorah and Eshtaol in the burying place of Manoah his father. And he judged Israel twenty years.

Judges 18:8

And they came unto *their brethren* to Zorah and Eshtaol: and their brethren said unto them, What say ye?

Judges 18:14

Then answered the five men that went to spy out the country of Laish, and said unto *their brethren*, Do ye know that there is in these houses an ephod, and teraphim, and a graven image, and a molten image? now therefore consider what ye have to do.

Judges 19:23

And the man, the master of the house, went out unto them, Nay, *my brethren*, nay, I pray you, do not so wickedly; seeing that this man is come into mine house, do not this folly.

Judges 20:13

Now therefore deliver us the men, the children of Belial, which are in Gibeah, that we may put them to death, and put away evil from Israel. But the children of Benjamin would not hearken to the voice of *their brethren* the children of Israel:

Judges 20:23

(And the children of Israel went up and wept before the Lord until even, and asked counsel of the Lord, saying, Shall I go up again to battle against the children of Benjamin *my brother*? And the Lord said, Go up against him.)

Judges 20:28

And Phinehas, the son of Eleazar, the son of Aaron, stood before it in those days,) saying, Shall I yet again go out to battle against the children of Benjamin *my brother*, or shall I cease? And the Lord said, Go up; for to morrow I will deliver them into thine hand.

Judges 21:6

And the children of Israel repented them for Benjamin *their brother*, and said, There is one tribe cut off from Israel this day.

Judges 21:22

And it shall be, when their fathers or *their brethren* come unto us to complain, that we will say unto them, Be favourable unto them for our sakes: because we reserved not to each man his wife in the war: for ye did not give unto them at this time, that ye should be guilty.

Ruth 4:3

And he said unto the kinsman, Naomi, that is come again out of the country of Moab, selleth a parcel of land, which was *our brother* Elimelech's:

Ruth 4:10

Moreover Ruth the Moabitess, the wife of Mahlon, have I purchased to be my wife, to raise up the name of the dead upon his inheritance, that the name of the dead be not cut off from among *his brethren*, and from the gate of his place: ye are witnesses this day.

I Samuel 14:3

And Ahiah, the son of Ahitub, Ichabod's *brother*, the son of Phinehas, the son of Eli, the Lord's priest in Shiloh, wearing an ephod. And the people knew not that Jonathan was gone.

I Samuel 16:13

Then Samuel took the horn of oil, and anointed him in the midst of *his brethren*: and the Spirit of the Lord came upon David from that day forward. So Samuel rose up, and went to Ramah.

I Samuel 17:17-18

And Jesse said unto David his son, Take now *for thy brethren* an ephah of this parched corn, and these ten loaves, and run to the camp *to thy brethren;* ¹⁸ And carry these ten cheeses unto the captain of their thousand, and look how *thy brethren* fare, and take their pledge.

I Samuel 17:22

And David left his carriage in the hand of the keeper of the carriage, and ran into the army, and came and saluted *his brethren*.

I Samuel 17:28

And Eliab *his* eldest *brother* heard when he spake unto the men; and Eliab's anger was kindled against David, and he said, Why camest thou down hither? and with whom hast thou left those few sheep in the wilderness? I know thy pride, and the naughtiness of thine heart; for thou art come down that thou mightest see the battle.

I Samuel 20:29

And he said, Let me go, I pray thee; for our family hath a sacrifice in the city; and *my brother*, he hath commanded me to be there: and now, if I have found favour in thine eyes, let me get away, I pray thee, and see my brethren. Therefore he cometh not unto the king's table.

I Samuel 22:1

David therefore departed thence, and escaped to the cave Adullam: and when *his brethren* and all his father's house heard it, they went down thither to him.

I Samuel 26:6

Then answered David and said to Ahimelech the Hittite, and to Abishai the son of Zeruiah, *brother* to Joab, saying, Who will go down with me to Saul to the camp? And Abishai said, I will go down with thee.

I Samuel 30:23

Then said David, Ye shall not do so, *my brethren*, with that which the Lord hath given us, who hath preserved us, and delivered the company that came against us into our hand.

II Samuel 1:26

I am distressed for thee, *my brother* Jonathan: very pleasant hast thou been unto me: thy love to me was wonderful, passing the love of women.

II Samuel 2:22

And Abner said again to Asahel, Turn thee aside from following me: wherefore should I smite thee to the ground? how then should I hold up my face to Joab *thy brother*?

II Samuel 2:26-27

Then Abner called to Joab, and said, Shall the sword devour for ever? knowest thou not that it will be bitterness in the latter end? how long shall it be then, ere thou bid the people return from following *their brethren*? ²⁷ And Joab said, As God liveth, unless thou hadst spoken, surely then in the morning the people had gone up every one from following *his brother*.

II Samuel 3:8

Then was Abner very wroth for the words of Ish-bosheth, and said, Am I a dog's head, which against Judah do shew kindness this day unto the house of Saul thy father, to *his brethren*, and to his friends, and have not delivered thee into the hand of David, that thou chargest me to day with a fault concerning this woman?

II Samuel 3:27

And when Abner was returned to Hebron, Joab took him aside in the gate to speak with him quietly, and smote him there under the fifth rib, that he died, for the blood of Asahel *his brother*.

II Samuel 3:30

So Joab and Abishai *his brother* slew Abner, because he had slain their brother Asahel at Gibeon in the battle.

II Samuel 4:6

And they came thither into the midst of the house, as though they would have fetched wheat; and they smote him under the fifth rib: and Rechab and Baanah *his brother* escaped.

II Samuel 4:9

And David answered Rechab and Baanah *his brother*, the sons of Rimmon the Beerothite, and said unto them, As the Lord liveth, who hath redeemed my soul out of all adversity,

II Samuel 10:10

And the rest of the people he delivered into the hand of Abishai *his brother*, that he might put them in array against the children of Ammon.

II Samuel 13:3-4

But Amnon had a friend, whose name was Jonadab, the son of Shimeah David's **brother**: and Jonadab was a very subtil man. ⁴ And he said unto him, Why art thou, being the king's son, lean from day to day? wilt thou not tell me? And Amnon said unto him, I love Tamar, **my brother** Absalom's sister.

II Samuel 13:7-8

Then David sent home to Tamar, saying, Go now to *thy brother* Amnon's house, and dress him meat. ⁸ So Tamar went to *her brother* Amnon's house; and he was laid down. And she took flour, and kneaded it, and made cakes in his sight, and did bake the cakes.

II Samuel 13:10

And Amnon said unto Tamar, Bring the meat into the chamber, that I may eat of thine hand. And Tamar took the cakes which she had made, and brought them into the chamber to Amnon *her brother*.

II Samuel 13:12

And she answered him, Nay, *my broth*er, do not force me; for no such thing ought to be done in Israel: do not thou this folly.

II Samuel 13:20

And Absalom *her brother* said unto her, Hath Amnon thy brother been with thee? but hold now thy peace, my sister: he is thy brother; regard not this thing. So Tamar remained desolate in *her brother* Absalom's house.

II Samuel 13:26

Then said Absalom, If not, I pray thee, let *my brother* Amnon go with us. And the king said unto him, Why should he go with thee?

II Samuel 13:32

And Jonadab, the son of Shimeah David's *brother*, answered and said, Let not my lord suppose that they have slain all the young men the king's sons; for Amnon only is dead: for by the appointment of Absalom this hath been determined from the day that he forced his sister Tamar.

II Samuel 14:7

And, behold, the whole family is risen against thine handmaid, and they said, Deliver him that smote *his brother*, that we may kill him, for the life of his brother whom he slew; and we will destroy the heir also: and so they shall quench my coal which is left, and shall not leave to my husband neither name nor remainder upon the earth.

II Samuel 15:20

Whereas thou camest but yesterday, should I this day make thee go up and down with us? seeing I go whither I may, return thou, and take back *thy brethren*: mercy and truth be with thee.

II Samuel 18:2

And David sent forth a third part of the people under the hand of Joab, and a third part under the hand of Abishai the son of Zeruiah, Joab's *brother*, and a third part under the hand of Ittai the Gittite. And the king said unto the people, I will surely go forth with you myself also.

II Samuel 19:12

Ye are *my brethren*, ye are my bones and my flesh: wherefore then are ye the last to bring back the king?

II Samuel 19:41

And, behold, all the men of Israel came to the king, and said unto the king, Why have *our brethren* the men of Judah stolen thee away, and have brought the king, and his household, and all David's men with him, over Jordan?

II Samuel 20:9-10

And Joab said to Amasa, Art thou in health, *my brother*? And Joab took Amasa by the beard with the right hand to kiss him. ¹⁰ But Amasa took no heed to the sword that was in Joab's hand: so he smote him therewith in the fifth rib, and shed out his bowels to the ground, and struck him not again; and he died. So Joab and Abishai *his brother* pursued after Sheba the son of Bichri.

II Samuel 21:21

And when he defied Israel, Jonathan the son of Shimea the brother of David slew him.

II Samuel 23:18

And Abishai, *the brother of* Joab, the son of Zeruiah, was chief among three. And he lifted up his spear against three hundred, and slew them, and had the name among three.

II Samuel 23:24

Asahel the brother of Joab was one of the thirty; Elhanan the son of Dodo of Bethlehem,

I Kings 1:9-10

And Adonijah slew sheep and oxen and fat cattle by the stone of Zoheleth, which is by Enrogel, and called all *his brethren* the king's sons, and all the men of Judah the king's servants: ¹⁰ But Nathan the prophet, and Benaiah, and the mighty men, and Solomon *his brother*, he called not.

I Kings 2:7

But shew kindness unto the sons of Barzillai the Gileadite, and let them be of those that eat at thy table: for so they came to me when I fled because of Absalom *thy brother*.

I Kings 2:15

And he said, Thou knowest that the kingdom was mine, and that all Israel set their faces on me, that I should reign: howbeit the kingdom is turned about, and is become *my brother's*: for it was his from the Lord.

I Kings 2:21-22

And she said, Let Abishag the Shunammite be given to Adonijah *thy brother* to wife.

²² And king Solomon answered and said unto his mother, And why dost thou ask Abishag the Shunammite for Adonijah? ask for him the kingdom also; for he is mine elder *brother*; even for him, and for Abiathar the priest, and for Joab the son of Zeruiah.

I Kings 9:13

And he said, What cities are these which thou hast given me, *my brother*? And he called them the land of Cabul unto this day.

I Kings 12:24

Thus saith the Lord, Ye shall not go up, nor fight against *your brethren* the children of Israel: return every man to his house; for this thing is from me. They hearkened therefore to the word of the Lord, and returned to depart, according to the word of the Lord.

I Kings 13:30

And he laid his carcase in his own grave; and they mourned over him, saying, Alas, *my brother!*

I Kings 20:32-33

So they girded sackcloth on their loins, and put ropes on their heads, and came to the king of Israel, and said, Thy servant Ben-hadad saith, I pray thee, let me live. And he said, Is he yet alive? he is *my brother*. ³³ Now the men did diligently observe whether any thing would come from him, and did hastily catch it: and they said, *Thy brother* Ben-hadad. Then he said, Go ye, bring him. Then Ben-hadad came forth to him; and he caused him to come up into the chariot.

II Kings 7:6

For the Lord had made the host of the Syrians to hear a noise of chariots, and a noise of horses, even the noise of a great host: and they said one to *another*, Lo, the king of Israel hath hired against us the kings of the Hittites, and the kings of the Egyptians, to come upon us.

II Kings 9:2

And when thou comest thither, look out there Jehu the son of Jehoshaphat the son of Nimshi, and go in, and make him arise up from among *his brethren*, and carry him to an inner chamber;

II Kings 10:13

Jehu met with *the brethren* of Ahaziah king of Judah, and said, Who are ye? And they answered, We are *the brethren* of Ahaziah; and we go down to salute the children of the king and the children of the queen.

II Kings 23:9

Nevertheless the priests of the high places came not up to the altar of the Lord in Jerusalem, but they did eat of the unleavened bread among *their brethren*.

I Chronicles 1:19

And unto Eber were born two sons: the name of the one was Peleg; because in his days the earth was divided: and *his brother's* name was Joktan.

I Chronicles 2:32

And the sons of Jada *the brother of* Shammai; Jether and Jonathan: and Jether died without children.

I Chronicles 2:42

Now the sons of Caleb *the brother of* Jerahmeel were, Mesha his firstborn, which was the father of Ziph; and the sons of Mareshah the father of Hebron.

I Chronicles 4:9

And Jabez was more honourable than *his brethren*: and his mother called his name Jabez, saying, Because I bare him with sorrow.

I Chronicles 4:11

And Chelub *the brother of* Shuah begat Mehir, which was the father of Eshton.

I Chronicles 4:27

And Shimei had sixteen sons and six daughters; but *his brethren* had not many children, neither did all their family multiply, like to the children of Judah.

I Chronicles 5:2

For Judah prevailed above *his brethren*, and of him came the chief ruler; but the birthright was Joseph's:)

I Chronicles 5:7

And *his brethren* by their families, when the genealogy of their generations was reckoned, were the chief, Jeiel, and Zechariah,

I Chronicles 5:13

And *their brethren* of the house of their fathers were, Michael, and Meshullam, and Sheba, and Jorai, and Jachan, and Zia, and Heber, seven.

I Chronicles 6:39

And *his brother* Asaph, who stood on his right hand, even Asaph the son of Berachiah, the son of Shimea,

I Chronicles 6:44

And *their brethren* the sons of Merari stood on the left hand: Ethan the son of Kishi, the son of Abdi, the son of Malluch,

I Chronicles 6:48

Their brethren also the Levites were appointed unto all manner of service of the tabernacle of the house of God.

I Chronicles 7:5

And *their brethren* among all the families of Issachar were valiant men of might, reckoned in all by their genealogies fourscore and seven thousand.

I Chronicles 7:16

And Maachah the wife of Machir bare a son, and she called his name Peresh; and the name of *his brother* was Sheresh; and his sons were Ulam and Rakem.

I Chronicles 7:22

And Ephraim their father mourned many days, and *his brethren* came to comfort him.

I Chronicles 7:35

And the sons of *his brother* Helem; Zophah, and Imna, and Shelesh, and Amal.

I Chronicles 8:32

And Mikloth begat Shimeah. And these also dwelt with *their brethren* in Jerusalem, over against them.

I Chronicles 8:39

And the sons of Eshek *his brother* were, Ulam his firstborn, Jehush the second, and Eliphelet the third.

I Chronicles 9:6

And of the sons of Zerah; Jeuel, and *their brethren*, six hundred and ninety.

I Chronicles 9:9

And *their brethren*, according to their generations, nine hundred and fifty and six. All these men were chief of the fathers in the house of their fathers.

I Chronicles 9:13

And *their brethren*, heads of the house of their fathers, a thousand and seven hundred and threescore; very able men for the work of the service of the house of God.

I Chronicles 9:17

And the porters were, Shallum, and Akkub, and Talmon, and Ahiman, and *their brethren*: Shallum was the chief;

I Chronicles 9:19

And Shallum the son of Kore, the son of Ebiasaph, the son of Korah, and *his brethren*, of the house of his father, the Korahites, were over the work of the service, keepers of the gates of the tabernacle: and their fathers, being over the host of the Lord, were keepers of the entry.

I Chronicles 9:25

And *their brethren*, which were in their villages, were to come after seven days from time to time with them.

I Chronicles 9:32

And other of *their brethren*, of the sons of the Kohathites, were over the shewbread, to prepare it every sabbath.

I Chronicles 9:38

And Mikloth begat Shimeam. And they also dwelt with *their brethren* at Jerusalem, over against *their brethren*.

I Chronicles 11:20

And Abishai *the brother of* Joab, he was chief of the three: for lifting up his spear against three hundred, he slew them, and had a name among the three.

I Chronicles 11:26

Also the valiant men of the armies were, Asahel *the brother of* Joab, Elhanan the son of Dodo of Bethlehem,

I Chronicles 11:38 Joel *the brother of* Nathan, Mibhar the son of Haggeri,

I Chronicles 11:45

Jediael the son of Shimri, and Joha his brother, the Tizite,

I Chronicles 12:2

They were armed with bows, and could use both the right hand and the left in hurling stones and shooting arrows out of a bow, even of Saul's *brethren* of Benjamin.

I Chronicles 12:29

And of the children of Benjamin, *the kindred of* Saul, three thousand: for hitherto the greatest part of them had kept the ward of the house of Saul.

I Chronicles 12:32

And of the children of Issachar, which were men that had understanding of the times, to know what Israel ought to do; the heads of them were two hundred; and all *their brethren* were at their commandment.

I Chronicles 12:39

And there they were with David three days, eating and drinking: for *their brethren* had prepared for them.

I Chronicles 13:2

And David said unto all the congregation of Israel, If it seem good unto you, and that it be of the Lord our God, let us send abroad unto *our brethren* every where, that are left in all the land of Israel, and with them also to the priests and Levites which are in their cities and suburbs, that they may gather themselves unto us:

I Chronicles 15:5-10

Of the sons of Kohath; Uriel the chief, *and his brethren* an hundred and twenty: ⁶ Of the sons of Merari; Asaiah the chief, *and his brethren* two hundred and twenty: ⁷ Of the sons of Gershom; Joel the chief, *and his brethren* an hundred and thirty: ⁸ Of the sons of Elizaphan; Shemaiah the chief, *and his brethren* two hundred: ⁹ Of the sons of Hebron; Eliel the chief, *and his brethren* fourscore: ¹⁰ Of the sons of Uzziel; Amminadab the chief, *and his brethren* an hundred and twelve.

I Chronicles 15:12

And said unto them, Ye are the chief of the fathers of the Levites: sanctify yourselves, both ye *and your brethren*, that ye may bring up the ark of the Lord God of Israel unto the place that I have prepared for it.

I Chronicles 15:16

And David spake to the chief of the Levites to appoint *their brethren* to be the singers with instruments of musick, psalteries and harps and cymbals, sounding, by lifting up the voice with joy. ¹⁷ So the Levites appointed Heman the son of Joel; and of *his brethren*, Asaph the son of Berechiah; and of the sons of Merari their brethren, Ethan the son of Kushaiah; ¹⁸ And with them *their brethren* of the second degree, Zechariah, Ben, and Jaaziel, and Shemiramoth, and Jehiel, and Unni, Eliab, and Benaiah, and Maaseiah, and Mattithiah, and Elipheleh, and Mikneiah, and Obed-edom, and Jeiel, the porters.

I Chronicles 16:7

Then on that day David delivered first this psalm to thank the Lord into the hand of Asaph and *his brethren.*

I Chronicles 16:37-39

So he left there before the ark of the covenant of the Lord Asaph and *his brethren*, to minister before the ark continually, as every day's work required: ³⁸ And Obed-edom with *their brethren*, threescore and eight; Obed-edom also the son of Jeduthun and Hosah to be porters: ³⁹ And Zadok the priest, and *his brethren* the priests, before the tabernacle of the Lord in the high place that was at Gibeon,

I Chronicles 19:11

And the rest of the people he delivered unto the hand of Abishai *his brother*, and they set themselves in array against the children of Ammon.

I Chronicles 19:15

And when the children of Ammon saw that the Syrians were fled, they likewise fled before Abishai *his brother*, and entered into the city. Then Joab came to Jerusalem.

I Chronicles 20:5

And there was war again with the Philistines; and Elhanan the son of Jair slew Lahmi *the brother of* Goliath the Gittite, whose spear staff was like a weaver's beam.

I Chronicles 20:7

But when he defied Israel, Jonathan the son of Shimea David's *brother* slew him.

I Chronicles 23:22

And Eleazar died, and had no sons, but daughters: and *their brethren* the sons of Kish took them.

I Chronicles 23:32

And that they should keep the charge of the tabernacle of the congregation, and the charge of the holy place, and the charge of the sons of Aaron *their brethren*, in the service of the house of the Lord.

I Chronicles 24:25

The brother of Michah was Isshiah: of the sons of Isshiah; Zechariah.

I Chronicles 24:31

These likewise cast lots over against *their brethren* the sons of Aaron in the presence of David the king, and Zadok, and Ahimelech, and the chief of the fathers of the priests and Levites, even the principal fathers over against their younger brethren.

I Chronicles 25:7

So the number of them, with *their brethren* that were instructed in the songs of the Lord, even all that were cunning, was two hundred fourscore and eight.

I Chronicles 25:9-31

Now the first lot came forth for Asaph to Joseph: the second to Gedaliah, who *with his brethren* and sons were twelve: ¹⁰ The third to Zaccur, he, his sons, *and his brethren*, were twelve: ¹¹ The fourth to Izri, he, his sons, *and his brethren*, were twelve: ¹² The fifth to Nethaniah, he, his sons, *and his brethren*, were twelve:

³⁰ The three and twentieth to Mahazioth, he, his sons, *and his brethren*, were twelve: ³¹ The four and twentieth to Romamti-ezer, he, his sons, *and his brethren*, were twelve.

I Chronicles 26:7-9

The sons of Shemaiah; Othni, and Rephael, and Obed, Elzabad, *whose brethren* were strong men, Elihu, and Semachiah. ⁸ All these of the sons of Obed-edom: they and their sons and *their brethren*, able men for strength for the service, were threescore and two of Obed-edom. ⁹ And Meshelemiah had sons and *brethren*, strong men, eighteen.

I Chronicles 26:11-12

Hilkiah the second, Tebaliah the third, Zechariah the fourth: all the sons and *brethren* of Hosah were thirteen. ¹² Among these were the divisions of the porters, even among the chief men, having wards one against *another*, to minister in the house of the Lord.

I Chronicles 26:22

The sons of Jehieli; Zetham, and Joel *his brother*, which were over the treasures of the house of the Lord.

I Chronicles 26:25

And his brethren by Eliezer; Rehabiah his son, and Jeshaiah his son, and Joram his son, and Zichri his son, and Shelomith his son. ²⁶ Which Shelomith *and his brethren* were over all the treasures of the dedicated things, which David the king, and the chief fathers, the captains over thousands and hundreds, and the captains of the host, had dedicated.

I Chronicles 26:28

And all that Samuel the seer, and Saul the son of Kish, and Abner the son of Ner, and Joab the son of Zeruiah, had dedicated; and whosoever had dedicated any thing, it was under the hand of Shelomith, *and of his brethren*.

I Chronicles 26:30

And of the Hebronites, Hashabiah *and his brethren*, men of valour, a thousand and seven hundred, were officers among them of Israel on this side Jordan westward in all the business of the Lord, and in the service of the king.

I Chronicles 26:32

And his brethren, men of valour, were two thousand and seven hundred chief fathers, whom king David made rulers over the Reubenites, the Gadites, and the half tribe of Manasseh, for every matter pertaining to God, and affairs of the king.

I Chronicles 27:7

The fourth captain for the fourth month was Asahel *the brother of* Joab, and Zebadiah his son after him: and in his course were twenty and four thousand.

I Chronicles 27:18

Of Judah, Elihu, one of the brethren of David: of Issachar, Omri the son of Michael:

I Chronicles 28:2

Then David the king stood up upon his feet, and said, Hear me, *my brethren*, and my people: As for me, I had in mine heart to build an house of rest for the ark of the covenant of the Lord, and for the footstool of our God, and had made ready for the building:

II Chronicles 5:12

Also the Levites which were the singers, all of them of Asaph, of Heman, of Jeduthun, with their sons and *their brethren*, being arrayed in white linen, having cymbals and psalteries and harps, stood at the east end of the altar, and with them an hundred and twenty priests sounding with trumpets:

II Chronicles 11:4

Thus saith the Lord, Ye shall not go up, nor fight against *your brethren*: return every man to his house: for this thing is done of me. And they obeyed the words of the Lord, and returned from going against Jeroboam.

II Chronicles 11:22

And Rehoboam made Abijah the son of Maachah the chief, to be ruler among *his brethren:* for he thought to make him king.

II Chronicles 19:10

And what cause soever shall come to you *of your brethren* that dwell in their cities, between blood and blood, between law and commandment, statutes and judgments, ye shall even warn them that they trespass not against the Lord, and so wrath come upon you, and upon *your brethren*: this do, and ye shall not trespass.

II Chronicles 21:2

And he had *brethren* the sons of Jehoshaphat, Azariah, and Jehiel, and Zechariah, and Azariah, and Michael, and Shephatiah: all these were the sons of Jehoshaphat king of Israel.

II Chronicles 21:4

Now when Jehoram was risen up to the kingdom of his father, he strengthened himself, and slew all *his brethren* with the sword, and divers also of the princes of Israel.

INSIGHTS FROM PROVERBS

A Brother

II Chronicles 21:13

But hast walked in the way of the kings of Israel, and hast made Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem to go a whoring, like to the whoredoms of the house of Ahab, and also hast slain *thy brethren* of thy father's house, which were better than thyself:

II Chronicles 22:8

And it came to pass, that, when Jehu was executing judgment upon the house of Ahab, and found the princes of Judah, and the sons of *the brethren of* Ahaziah, that ministered to Ahaziah, he slew them.

II Chronicles 28:11

Now hear me therefore, and deliver the captives again, which ye have taken captive of *your brethren*: for the fierce wrath of the Lord is upon you.

II Chronicles 28:15

And the men which were expressed by name rose up, and took the captives, and with the spoil clothed all that were naked among them, and arrayed them, and shod them, and gave them to eat and to drink, and anointed them, and carried all the feeble of them upon asses, and brought them to Jericho, the city of palm trees, to *their brethren*: then they returned to Samaria.

II Chronicles 29:15

And they gathered *their brethren*, and sanctified themselves, and came, according to the commandment of the king, by the words of the Lord, to cleanse the house of the Lord.

II Chronicles 29:34

But the priests were too few, so that they could not flay all the burnt offerings: wherefore *their brethren* the Levites did help them, till the work was ended, and until the other priests had sanctified themselves: for the Levites were more upright in heart to sanctify themselves than the priests.

II Chronicles 30:7

And be not ye like your fathers, and like *your brethren*, which trespassed against the Lord God of their fathers, who therefore gave them up to desolation, as ye see.

II Chronicles 30:9

For if ye turn again unto the Lord, *your brethren* and your children shall find compassion before them that lead them captive, so that they shall come again into this land: for the Lord your God is gracious and merciful, and will not turn away his face from you, if ye return unto him.

II Chronicles 31:12-13

And brought in the offerings and the tithes and the dedicated things faithfully: over which Cononiah the Levite was ruler, and Shimei *his brother* was the next. ¹³ And Jehiel, and Azaziah, and Nahath, and Asahel, and Jerimoth, and Jozabad, and Eliel, and Ismachiah, and Mahath, and Benaiah, were overseers under the hand of Cononiah and Shimei *his brother*, at the commandment of Hezekiah the king, and Azariah the ruler of the house of God.

II Chronicles 31:15

And next him were Eden, and Miniamin, and Jeshua, and Shemaiah, Amariah, and Shecaniah, in the cities of the priests, in their set office, to give to *their brethren* by courses, as well to the great as to the small:

II Chronicles 35:5-6

And stand in the holy place according to the divisions of the families of the fathers of *your brethren* the people, and after the division of the families of the Levites. ⁶ So kill the passover, and sanctify yourselves, and prepare *your brethren*, that they may do according to the word of the Lord by the hand of Moses.

II Chronicles 35:9

Conaniah also, and Shemaiah and Nethaneel, *his brethren*, and Hashabiah and Jeiel and Jozabad, chief of the Levites, gave unto the Levites for passover offerings five thousand small cattle, and five hundred oxen.

II Chronicles 35:15

And the singers the sons of Asaph were in their place, according to the commandment of David, and Asaph, and Heman, and Jeduthun the king's seer; and the porters waited at every gate; they might not depart from their service; for *their brethren* the Levites prepared for them.

II Chronicles 36:4

And the king of Egypt made Eliakim *his brother* king over Judah and Jerusalem, and turned his name to Jehoiakim. And Necho took Jehoahaz his brother, and carried him to Egypt.

II Chronicles 36:10

And when the year was expired, king Nebuchadnezzar sent, and brought him to Babylon, with the goodly vessels of the house of the Lord, and made Zedekiah *his brother* king over Judah and Jerusalem.

Ezra 3:2

Then stood up Jeshua the son of Jozadak, and *his brethren* the priests, and Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, and his brethren, and builded the altar of the God of Israel, to offer burnt offerings thereon, as it is written in the law of Moses the man of God.

Ezra 3:8-9

Now in the second year of their coming unto the house of God at Jerusalem, in the second month, began Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, and Jeshua the son of Jozadak, and the remnant of *their brethren* the priests and the Levites, and all they that were come out of the captivity unto Jerusalem; and appointed the Levites, from twenty years old and upward, to set forward the work of the house of the Lord. ⁹ Then stood Jeshua with his sons and *his brethren*, Kadmiel and his sons, the sons of Judah, together, to set forward the workmen in the house of God: the sons of Henadad, with their sons and their brethren the Levites.

Ezra 6:20

For the priests and the Levites were purified together, all of them were pure, and killed the passover for all the children of the captivity, and for *their brethren* the priests, and for themselves.

Ezra 8:17-19

And I sent them with commandment unto Iddo the chief at the place Casiphia, and I told them what they should say unto Iddo, and to *his brethren* the Nethinims, at the place Casiphia, that they should bring unto us ministers for the house of our God. ¹⁸ And by the good hand of our God upon us they brought us a man of understanding, of the sons of Mahli, the son of Levi, the son of Israel; and Sherebiah, with his sons and *his brethren*, eighteen; ¹⁹ And Hashabiah, and with him Jeshaiah of the sons of Merari, *his brethren* and their sons, twenty;

Ezra 8:24

Then I separated twelve of the chief of the priests, Sherebiah, Hashabiah, and ten of *their brethren* with them,

Ezra 10:18

And among the sons of the priests there were found that had taken strange wives: namely, of the sons of Jeshua the son of Jozadak, and *his brethren*; Maaseiah, and Eliezer, and Jarib, and Gedaliah.

Nehemiah 1:2

That Hanani, one of *my brethren*, came, he and certain men of Judah; and I asked them concerning the Jews that had escaped, which were left of the captivity, and concerning Jerusalem.

Nehemiah 3:1

Then Eliashib the high priest rose up with *his brethren* the priests, and they builded the sheep gate; they sanctified it, and set up the doors of it; even unto the tower of Meah they sanctified

Nehemiah 3:18

After him repaired *their brethren*, Bavai the son of Henadad, the ruler of the half part of Keilah.

Nehemiah 4:2

And he spake before *his brethren* and the army of Samaria, and said, What do these feeble Jews? will they fortify themselves? will they sacrifice? will they make an end in a day? will they revive the stones out of the heaps of the rubbish which are burned?

Nehemiah 4:14

And I looked, and rose up, and said unto the nobles, and to the rulers, and to the rest of the people, Be not ye afraid of them: remember the Lord, which is great and terrible, and fight for *your brethren*, your sons, and your daughters, your wives, and your houses.

Nehemiah 4:19

And I said unto the nobles, and to the rulers, and to the rest of the people, The work is great and large, and we are separated upon the wall, one far from *another*.

Nehemiah 4:23

So neither I, nor *my brethren*, nor my servants, nor the men of the guard which followed me, none of us put off our clothes, saving that every one put them off for washing.

Nehemiah 5:1

And there was a great cry of the people and of their wives against *their brethren* the Jews.

Nehemiah 5:5

Yet now our flesh is as the flesh of *our brethren*, our children as their children: and, lo, we bring into bondage our sons and our daughters to be servants, and some of our daughters are brought unto bondage already: neither is it in our power to redeem them; for other men have our lands and vineyards.

Nehemiah 5:7-8

Then I consulted with myself, and I rebuked the nobles, and the rulers, and said unto them, Ye exact usury, every one of *his brother*. And I set a great assembly against them. ⁸ And I said unto them, We after our ability have redeemed *our brethren* the Jews, which were sold unto the heathen; and will ye even sell your brethren? or shall they be sold unto us? Then held they their peace, and found nothing to answer.

Nehemiah 5:10

I likewise, and *my brethren*, and my servants, might exact of them money and corn: I pray you, let us leave off this usury.

Nehemiah 5:14

Moreover from the time that I was appointed to be their governor in the land of Judah, from the twentieth year even unto the two and thirtieth year of Artaxerxes the king, that is, twelve years, I and *my brethren* have not eaten the bread of the governor.

Nehemiah 7:2

That I gave *my brother* Hanani, and Hananiah the ruler of the palace, charge over Jerusalem: for he was a faithful man, and feared God above many.

Nehemiah 10:10

And their brethren, Shebaniah, Hodijah, Kelita, Pelaiah, Hanan,

Nehemiah 10:29

They clave to *their brethren*, their nobles, and entered into a curse, and into an oath, to walk in God's law, which was given by Moses the servant of God, and to observe and do all the commandments of the Lord our Lord, and his judgments and his statutes;

Nehemiah 11:12-14

And their brethren that did the work of the house were eight hundred twenty and two: and Adaiah the son of Jeroham, the son of Pelaliah, the son of Amzi, the son of Zechariah, the son of Pashur, the son of Malchiah, ¹³ **And his brethren**, chief of the fathers, two hundred forty and two: and Amashai the son of Azareel, the son of Ahasai, the son of Meshillemoth, the son of Immer, ¹⁴ **And their brethren**, mighty men of valour, an hundred twenty and eight: and their overseer was Zabdiel, the son of one of the great men.

Nehemiah 11:17

And Mattaniah the son of Micha, the son of Zabdi, the son of Asaph, was the principal to begin the thanksgiving in prayer: and Bakbukiah the second among *his brethren*, and Abda the son of Shammua, the son of Galal, the son of Jeduthun.

Nehemiah 11:19

Moreover the porters, Akkub, Talmon, and *their brethren* that kept the gates, were an hundred seventy and two.

Nehemiah 12:7

Sallu, Amok, Hilkiah, Jedaiah. These were the chief of the priests and of *their brethren* in the days of Jeshua. ⁸ Moreover the Levites: Jeshua, Binnui, Kadmiel, Sherebiah, Judah, and Mattaniah, which was over the thanksgiving, he and *his brethren*. ⁹ Also Bakbukiah and Unni, *their brethren*, were over against them in the watches.

Nehemiah 12:24

And the chief of the Levites: Hashabiah, Sherebiah, and Jeshua the son of Kadmiel, with *their brethren* over against them, to praise and to give thanks, according to the commandment of David the man of God, ward over against ward.

Nehemiah 12:36

And his brethren, Shemaiah, and Azarael, Milalai, Gilalai, Maai, Nethaneel, and Judah, Hanani, with the musical instruments of David the man of God, and Ezra the scribe before them.

Nehemiah 13:13

And I made treasurers over the treasuries, Shelemiah the priest, and Zadok the scribe, and of the Levites, Pedaiah: and next to them was Hanan the son of Zaccur, the son of Mattaniah: for they were counted faithful, and their office was to distribute unto *their brethren*.

Esther 10:3

For Mordecai the Jew was next unto king Ahasuerus, and great among the Jews, and accepted of the multitude of *his brethren*, seeking the wealth of his people, and speaking peace to all his seed.

Job 1:13

And there was a day when his sons and his daughters were eating and drinking wine in *their* eldest *brother's* house:

Job 1:18

While he was yet speaking, there came also another, and said, Thy sons and thy daughters were eating and drinking wine in *their* eldest *brother's* house:

Job 6:15

My brethren have dealt deceitfully as a brook, and as the stream of brooks they pass away;

Job 19:13

He hath put *my brethren* far from me, and mine acquaintance are verily estranged from me.

Job 22:6

For thou hast taken a pledge from *thy brother* for nought, and stripped the naked of their clothing.

Job 30:29

I am a *brother* to dragons, and a companion to owls.

Job 41:17

They are joined one to *another*, they stick together, that they cannot be sundered.

Job 42:11

Then came there unto him all *his brethren*, and all his sisters, and all they that had been of his acquaintance before, and did eat bread with him in his house: and they bemoaned him, and comforted him over all the evil that the Lord had brought upon him: every man also gave him a piece of money, and every one an earring of gold.

Job 42:15

And in all the land were no women found so fair as the daughters of Job: and their father gave them inheritance among *their brethren*.

Psalms 22:22

I will declare thy name *unto my brethren*: in the midst of the congregation will I praise thee.

Psalms 35:14

I behaved myself as though he had been my friend or *brother*: I bowed down heavily, as one that mourneth for his mother.

Psalms 49:7 None of them can by any means redeem *his brother*, nor give to God a ransom for him:

Psalms 50:20

Thou sittest and speakest *against thy brother*; thou slanderest thine own mother's son.

Psalms 69:8

I am become a stranger *unto my brethren*, and an alien unto my mother's children.

Psalms 122:8

For *my brethren* and companions' sakes, I will now say, Peace be within thee.

Psalms 133:1

Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for *brethren* to dwell together in unity!

Proverbs 6:19

A false witness that speaketh lies, and he that soweth discord among brethren.

Proverbs 17:2

A wise servant shall have rule over a son that causeth shame, and shall have part of the inheritance among *the brethren*.

Proverbs 17:17

A friend loveth at all times, *and a brother* is born for adversity.

Proverbs 18:9

He also that is slothful in his work is *brother* to him that is a great waster.

Proverbs 18:19

A brother offended is harder to be won than a strong city: and their contentions are like the bars of a castle.

Proverbs 18:24

A man that hath friends must shew himself friendly: and there is a friend that sticketh closer *than a brother*.

Proverbs 19:7

All *the brethren of* the poor do hate him: how much more do his friends go far from him? he pursueth them with words, yet they are wanting to him.

Proverbs 27:10

Thine own friend, and thy father's friend, forsake not; neither go into *thy brother's house* in the day of thy calamity: for better is a neighbour that is near *than a brother* far off.

Ecclesiastes 4:8

There is one alone, and there is not a second; yea, he hath neither child *nor brother*: yet is there no end of all his labour; neither is his eye satisfied with riches; neither saith he, For whom do I labour, and bereave my soul of good? This is also vanity, yea, it is a sore travail.

Song of Solomon 8:1

O that thou wert as *my brother*, that sucked the breasts of my mother! when I should find thee without, I would kiss thee; yea, I should not be despised.

Isaiah 3:6

When a man shall take hold of *his brother* of the house of his father, saying, Thou hast clothing, be thou our ruler, and let this ruin be under thy hand:

Isaiah 9:19

Through the wrath of the Lord of hosts is the land darkened, and the people shall be as the fuel of the fire: no man shall spare *his brother*.

Isaiah 19:2

And I will set the Egyptians against the Egyptians: and they shall fight every one against *his brother*, and every one against his neighbour; city against city, and kingdom against kingdom.

Isaiah 41:6

They helped every one his neighbour; and every one said to *his brother*, Be of good courage.

Isaiah 66:5

Hear the word of the Lord, ye that tremble at his word; *your brethren* that hated you, that cast you out for my name's sake, said, Let the Lord be glorified: but he shall appear to your joy, and they shall be ashamed.

Isaiah 66:20

And they shall bring all *your brethren* for an offering unto the Lord out of all nations upon horses, and in chariots, and in litters, and upon mules, and upon swift beasts, to my holy mountain Jerusalem, saith the Lord, as the children of Israel bring an offering in a clean vessel into the house of the Lord.

Jeremiah 7:15

And I will cast you out of my sight, as I have cast out all *your brethren*, even the whole seed of Ephraim.

Jeremiah 9:4

Take ye heed every one of his neighbour, and trust ye not in any brother: for *every brother* will utterly supplant, and every neighbour will walk with slanders.

Jeremiah 12:6

For even *thy brethren*, and the house of thy father, even they have dealt treacherously with thee; yea, they have called a multitude after thee: believe them not, though they speak fair words unto thee.

Jeremiah 13:14

And I will dash them one against *another*, even the fathers and the sons together, saith the Lord: I will not pity, nor spare, nor have mercy, but destroy them.

Jeremiah 22:18

Therefore thus saith the Lord concerning Jehoiakim the son of Josiah king of Judah; They shall not lament for him, saying, Ah *my brother*! or, Ah sister! they shall not lament for him, saying, Ah lord! or, Ah his glory!

Jeremiah 23:35

Thus shall ye say every one to his neighbour, and every one to *his brother*, What hath the Lord answered? and, What hath the Lord spoken?

Jeremiah 25:26

And all the kings of the north, far and near, one with *another*, and all the kingdoms of the world, which are upon the face of the earth: and the king of Sheshach shall drink after them.

Jeremiah 29:16

Know that thus saith the Lord of the king that sitteth upon the throne of David, and of all the people that dwelleth in this city, and of *your brethren* that are not gone forth with you into captivity;

Jeremiah 31:34

And they shall teach no more every man his neighbour, and every man *his brother*, saying, Know the Lord: for they shall all know me, from the least of them unto the greatest of them, saith the Lord; for I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more.

Jeremiah 34:9

That every man should let his manservant, and every man his maidservant, being an Hebrew or an Hebrewess, go free; that none should serve himself of them, to wit, of a Jew *his brother*.

Jeremiah 34:14

At the end of seven years let ye go every man *his brother* an Hebrew, which hath been sold unto thee; and when he hath served thee six years, thou shalt let him go free from thee: but your fathers hearkened not unto me, neither inclined their ear.

Jeremiah 34:17

Therefore thus saith the Lord; Ye have not hearkened unto me, in proclaiming liberty, every one to *his brother*, and every man to his neighbour: behold, I proclaim a liberty for you, saith the Lord, to the sword, to the pestilence, and to the famine; and I will make you to be removed into all the kingdoms of the earth.

Jeremiah 35:3

Then I took Jaazaniah the son of Jeremiah, the son of Habaziniah, and *his brethren*, and all his sons, and the whole house of the Rechabites;

Jeremiah 41:8

But ten men were found among them that said unto Ishmael, Slay us not: for we have treasures in the field, of wheat, and of barley, and of oil, and of honey. So he forbare, and slew them not among *their brethren*.

Jeremiah 49:10

But I have made Esau bare, I have uncovered his secret places, and he shall not be able to hide himself: his seed is spoiled, and *his brethren*, and his neighbours, and he is not.

Ezekiel 4:17

That they may want bread and water, and be astonied one with *another*, and consume away for their iniquity.

Ezekiel 11:15

Son of man, *thy brethren*, even thy brethren, the men of thy kindred, and all the house of Israel wholly, are they unto whom the inhabitants of Jerusalem have said, Get you far from the Lord: unto us is this land given in possession.

Ezekiel 18:10

If he beget a son that is a robber, a shedder of blood, and that doeth *the like* to any one of these things,

Ezekiel 18:18

As for his father, because he cruelly oppressed, spoiled *his brother* by violence, and did that which is not good among his people, lo, even he shall die in his iniquity.

Ezekiel 24:23

And your tires shall be upon your heads, and your shoes upon your feet: ye shall not mourn nor weep; but ye shall pine away for your iniquities, and mourn one toward another.

Ezekiel 33:30

Also, thou son of man, the children of thy people still are talking against thee by the walls and in the doors of the houses, and speak one to another, every one to *his brother*, saying, Come, I pray you, and hear what is the word that cometh forth from the Lord.

Ezekiel 38:21

And I will call for a sword against him throughout all my mountains, saith the Lord God: every man's sword shall be against *his brother*.

Ezekiel 44:25

And they shall come at no dead person to defile themselves: but for father, or for mother, or for son, or for daughter, *for brother*, or for sister that hath had no husband, they may defile themselves.

Ezekiel 47:14

And ye shall inherit it, one *as well as another*: concerning the which I lifted up mine hand to give it unto your fathers: and this land shall fall unto you for inheritance.

Hosea 2:1

Say ye unto your brethren, Ammi; and to your sisters, Ru-hamah.

Hosea 12:3

He took *his brother* by the heel in the womb, and by his strength he had power with God:

Hosea 13:15

Though he be fruitful among *his brethren*, an east wind shall come, the wind of the Lord shall come up from the wilderness, and his spring shall become dry, and his fountain shall be dried up: he shall spoil the treasure of all pleasant vessels.

Joel 2:8

Neither shall one thrust *another*; they shall walk every one in his path: and when they fall upon the sword, they shall not be wounded.

Amos 1:9

Thus saith the Lord; For three transgressions of Tyrus, and for four, I will not turn away the punishment thereof; because they delivered up the whole captivity to Edom, and remembered not *the brotherly* covenant:

Amos 1:11

Thus saith the Lord; For three transgressions of Edom, and for four, I will not turn away the punishment thereof; because he did pursue *his brother* with the sword, and did cast off all pity, and his anger did tear perpetually, and he kept his wrath for ever:

Obadiah 10

For thy violence against *thy brother* Jacob shame shall cover thee, and thou shalt be cut off for ever.

Obadiah 12

But thou shouldest not have looked on the day of *thy brother* in the day that he became a stranger; neither shouldest thou have rejoiced over the children of Judah in the day of their destruction; neither shouldest thou have spoken proudly in the day of distress.

Micah 5:3

Therefore will he give them up, until the time that she which travaileth hath brought forth: then the remnant of *his brethren* shall return unto the children of Israel.

Micah 7:2

The good man is perished out of the earth: and there is none upright among men: they all lie in wait for blood; they hunt every man *his brother* with a net.

Haggai 2:22

Exodus 22:14

And if a man borrow ought of *his neighbour*, and it be hurt, or die, the owner thereof being not with it, he shall surely make it good.

Exodus 22:26-27

If thou at all take *thy neighbour's* raiment to pledge, thou shalt deliver it unto him by that the sun goeth down: ²⁷ And he said unto them, Thus saith the Lord God of Israel, Put every man his sword by his side, and go in and out from gate to gate throughout the camp, and slay every man his brother, and every man *his companion*, and every man his neighbour.

Exodus 33:11

And the Lord spake unto Moses face to face, as a man speaketh unto *his friend*. And he turned again into the camp: but his servant Joshua, the son of Nun, a young man, departed not out of the tabernacle.

Leviticus 19:13

Thou shalt not defraud *thy neighbour*, neither rob him: the wages of him that is hired shall not abide with thee all night until the morning.

Leviticus 19:16

Thou shalt not go up and down as a talebearer among thy people: neither shalt thou stand against the blood of *thy neighbour*: I am the Lord.

Leviticus 19:18

Thou shalt not avenge, nor bear any grudge against the children of thy people, but thou shalt love *thy neighbour* as thyself: I am the Lord.

Leviticus 20:10

And the man that committeth adultery with another man's wife, even he that committeth adultery with *his neighbour's* wife, the adulterer and the adulteress shall surely be put to death.

If thy brother, the son of thy mother, or thy son, or thy daughter, or the wife of thy bosom, or *thy friend*, which is as thine own soul, entice thee secretly, saying, Let us go and serve other gods, which thou hast not known, thou, nor thy fathers;

Deuteronomy 15:2

And this is the manner of the release: Every creditor that lendeth ought *unto his neighbour* shall release it; he shall not exact it of *his neighbour*, or of his brother; because it is called the Lord's release.

Deuteronomy 19:4

And this is the case of the slayer, which shall flee thither, that he may live: Whoso killeth *his neighbour* ignorantly, whom he hated not in time past; ⁵ As when a man goeth into the wood with *his neighbour* to hew wood, and his hand fetcheth a stroke with the axe to cut down the tree, and the head slippeth from the helve, and lighteth upon *his neighbour*, that he die; he shall flee unto one of those cities, and live:

But if any man hate *his neighbour*, and lie in wait for him, and rise up against him, and smite him mortally that he die, and fleeth into one of these cities:

Deuteronomy 19:14

Thou shalt not remove *thy neighbour's* landmark, which they of old time have set in thine inheritance, which thou shalt inherit in the land that the Lord thy God giveth thee to possess it.

Deuteronomy 22:24

Then ye shall bring them both out unto the gate of that city, and ye shall stone them with stones that they die; the damsel, because she cried not, being in the city; and the man, because he hath humbled *his neighbour's* wife: so thou shalt put away evil from among you.

Deuteronomy 22:26

But unto the damsel thou shalt do nothing; there is in the damsel no sin worthy of death: for as when a man riseth against *his neighbour*, and slayeth him, even so is this matter:

Deuteronomy 23:24

When thou comest into *thy neighbour's* vineyard, then thou mayest eat grapes thy fill at thine own pleasure; but thou shalt not put any in thy vessel. ²⁵ When thou comest into the standing corn of *thy neighbour*, then thou mayest pluck the ears with thine hand; but thou shalt not move a sickle unto *thy neighbour's* standing corn.

Deuteronomy 24:10

When thou dost lend *thy brother* any thing, thou shalt not go into his house to fetch his pledge.

Deuteronomy 27:17

Cursed be he that removeth *his neighbour's* landmark. And all the people shall say, Amen.

Deuteronomy 27:24

Cursed be he that smiteth *his neighbour* secretly. And all the people shall say, Amen.

Joshua 20:5

And if the avenger of blood pursue after him, then they shall not deliver the slayer up into his hand; because he smote *his neighbour* unwittingly, and hated him not beforetime.

Judges 6:29

And they said one to *another*, Who hath done this thing? And when they inquired and asked, they said, Gideon the son of Joash hath done this thing.

Judges 7:13-14

And when Gideon was come, behold, there was a man that told a dream *unto his fellow*, and said, Behold, I dreamed a dream, and, lo, a cake of barley bread tumbled into the host of Midian, and came unto a tent, and smote it that it fell, and overturned it, that the tent lay along. ¹⁴ And *his fellow* answered and said, This is nothing else save the sword of Gideon the son of Joash, a man of Israel: for into his hand hath God delivered Midian, and all the host.

And they said, This is blood: the kings are surely slain, and they have smitten one *another*: now therefore, Moab, to the spoil.

And there were four leprous men at the entering in of the gate: and they said one to *another*, Why sit we here until we die?

Have pity upon me, have pity upon me, 0 ye *my friends*; for the hand of God hath touched me.

Job 30:29

I am a brother to dragons, *and a companion* to owls.

Job 31:9

If mine heart have been deceived by a woman, or if I have laid wait at *my neighbour's* door;

Job 32:3

Also against *his* three *friends* was his wrath kindled, because they had found no answer, and yet had condemned Job.

Job 35:4

I will answer thee, and *thy companions* with thee.

Job 42:7

And it was so, that after the Lord had spoken these words unto Job, the Lord said to Eliphaz the Temanite, My wrath is kindled against thee, and against *thy* two *friends*: for ye have not spoken of me the thing that is right, as my servant Job hath.

Job 42:10

And the Lord turned the captivity of Job, when he prayed for *his friends*: also the Lord gave Job twice as much as he had before.

Psalms 12:2

They speak vanity every one with *his neighbour*: with flattering lips and with a double heart do they speak.

Psalms 15:3

He that backbiteth not with his tongue, nor doeth evil *to his neighbour*, nor taketh up a reproach against his neighbour.

Psalms 28:3

Draw me not away with the wicked, and with the workers of iniquity, which speak peace to *their neighbours*, but mischief is in their hearts.

Psalms 35:14

I behaved myself *as though* he had been my *friend* or brother: I bowed down heavily, as one that mourneth for his mother.

Psalms 38:11

My lovers and my friends stand aloof from my sore; and my kinsmen stand afar off.

Psalms 88:18

Lover *and friend* hast thou put far from me, and mine acquaintance into darkness.

Psalms 101:5

Whoso privily slandereth *his neighbour*, him will I cut off: him that hath an high look and a proud heart will not I suffer.

Psalms 122:8

For my brethren *and companions'* sakes, I will now say, Peace be within thee.

Proverbs 3:28-29

Say not *unto thy neighbour*, Go, and come again, and to morrow I will give; when thou hast it by thee. ²⁹ Devise not evil against *thy neighbour*, seeing he dwelleth securely by thee.

Proverbs 6:1

My son, if thou be surety *for thy friend*, if thou hast stricken thy hand with a stranger,

Proverbs 6:3

Do this now, my son, deliver thyself, when thou art come into the hand of *thy friend*; go, humble thyself, and make sure *thy friend*.

Proverbs 6:29

So he that goeth in to *his neighbour's* wife; whosoever toucheth her shall not be innocent.

Proverbs 11:9

An hypocrite with his mouth destroyeth *his neighbour*: but through knowledge shall the just be delivered.

Proverbs 11:12

He that is void of wisdom despiseth *his neighbour*: but a man of understanding holdeth his peace.

Proverbs 12:26

The righteous is more excellent *than his neighbour*: but the way of the wicked seduceth them.

Proverbs 14:20-21

The poor is hated even *of his own neighbour*: but the rich hath many friends. ²¹ He that despiseth *his neighbour* sinneth: but he that hath mercy on the poor, happy is he.

Proverbs 16:29

A violent man enticeth *his neighbour*, and leadeth him into the way that is not good.

Proverbs 17:17-18

A friend loveth at all times, and a brother is born for adversity. ¹⁸ A man void of understanding striketh hands, and becometh surety in the presence of *his friend*.

Proverbs 18:17

He that is first in his own cause seemeth just; but *his neighbour* cometh and searcheth him.

Proverbs 18:24

A man that hath *friends* must shew himself friendly: and there is a friend that sticketh closer than a brother.

Proverbs 19:4

Wealth maketh many *friends;* but the poor is separated *from his neighbour*.

Proverbs 19:6

Many will intreat the favour of the prince: and every man is *a friend* to him that giveth gifts.

Proverbs 21:10-11

The soul of the wicked desireth evil: *his neighbour* findeth no favour in his eyes. ¹¹ He that loveth pureness of heart, for the grace of his lips the king shall be *his friend*.

Proverbs 24:28

Be not a witness *against thy neighbour* without cause; and deceive not with thy lips.

Proverbs 25:8-9

Go not forth hastily to strive, lest thou know not what to do in the end thereof, when *thy neighbour* hath put thee to shame. ⁹ Debate thy cause with *thy neighbour* himself; and discover not a secret to another:

Proverbs 25:17

Withdraw thy foot from *thy neighbour's* house; lest he be weary of thee, and so hate thee. ¹⁸ A man that beareth false witness *against his neighbour* is a maul, and a sword, and a sharp arrow.

Proverbs 26:19

So is the man that deceiveth *his neighbour*, and saith, Am not I in sport?

Proverbs 27:9-10

Ointment and perfume rejoice the heart: so doth the sweetness of *a man's friend* by hearty counsel. ¹⁰ *Thine own friend, and* thy father's *friend,* forsake not; neither go into thy brother's house in the day of thy calamity: for better is a neighbour that is near than a brother far off.

Proverbs 27:14

He that blesseth *his friend* with a loud voice, rising early in the morning, it shall be counted a curse to him.

Proverbs 27:17

Iron sharpeneth iron; so a man sharpeneth the countenance of *his friend*.

Proverbs 29:5

A man that flattereth *his neighbour* spreadeth a net for his feet.

Ecclesiastes 4:4

Again, I considered all travail, and every right work, that for this a man is envied *of his neighbour*. This is also vanity and vexation of spirit.

Song of Solomon 5:1

I am come into my garden, my sister, my spouse: I have gathered my myrrh with my spice; I have eaten my honeycomb with my honey; I have drunk my wine with my milk: eat, *O friends;* drink, yea, drink abundantly, O beloved.

Song of Solomon 5:16

His mouth is most sweet: yea, he is altogether lovely. This is my beloved, and this is *my friend*, 0 daughters of Jerusalem.

Isaiah 3:5

And the people shall be oppressed, every one by another, and every one **by his neighbour**: the child shall behave himself proudly against the ancient, and the base against the honourable.

Isaiah 13:8

And they shall be afraid: pangs and sorrows shall take hold of them; they shall be in pain as a woman that travaileth: they shall be amazed one at *another*; their faces shall be as flames.

Isaiah 19:2

And I will set the Egyptians against the Egyptians: and they shall fight every one against his brother, and every one *against his neighbour*; city against city, and kingdom against kingdom.

Isaiah 34:14

The wild beasts of the desert shall also meet with the wild beasts of the island, and the satyr shall cry to *his fellow*; the screech owl also shall rest there, and find for herself a place of rest.

Isaiah 41:6

They helped every one *his neighbour*; and every one said to his brother, Be of good courage.

Jeremiah 3:1

They say, If a man put away his wife, and she go from him, and become another man's, shall he return unto her again? shall not that land be greatly polluted? but thou hast played the harlot with many *lovers*; yet return again to me, saith the Lord.

Jeremiah 3:20

Surely as a wife treacherously departeth *from her husband*, so have ye dealt treacherously with me, O house of Israel, saith the Lord.

Jeremiah 5:8

They were as fed horses in the morning: every one neighed after *his neighbour's* wife.

And I will cause them to eat the flesh of their sons and the flesh of their daughters, and they shall eat every one the flesh of *his friend* in the siege and straitness, wherewith their enemies, and they that seek their lives, shall straiten them.

Jeremiah 22:8

And many nations shall pass by this city, and they shall say every man to *his neighbour*, Wherefore hath the Lord done thus unto this great city?

Jeremiah 22:13

There came then his *brethren* and his mother, and, standing without, sent unto him, calling him. ³² And the multitude sat about him, and they said unto him, Behold, thy mother and thy *brethren* without seek for thee. ³³ And he answered them, saying, Who is my mother, or my *brethren*? ³⁴ And he looked round about on them which sat about him, and said, Behold my mother and my *brethren*! ³⁵ For whosoever shall do the will of God, the same is my *brother*, and my sister, and mother.

Mark 5:37

And he suffered no man to follow him, save Peter, and James, and John the *brother* of James.

Mark 6:3

Is not this the carpenter, the son of Mary, the *brother* of James, and Joses, and of Juda, and Simon? and are not his sisters here with us? And they were offended at him.

Mark 6:17-18

For Herod himself had sent forth and laid hold upon John, and bound him in prison for Herodias' sake, his *brother* Philip's wife: for he had married her. ¹⁸ For John had said unto Herod, It is not lawful for thee to have thy *brother's* wife.

Mark 10:29-30

And Jesus answered and said, Verily I say unto you, There is no man that hath left house, or *brethren*, or sisters, or father, or mother, or wife, or children, or lands, for my sake, and the gospel's, ³⁰ But he shall receive an hundredfold now in this time, houses, and *brethren*, and sisters, and mothers, and children, and lands, with persecutions; and in the world to come eternal life.

Mark 12:19-20

Master, Moses wrote unto us, If *a* man's *brother* die, and leave his wife behind him, and leave no children, that his brother should take his wife, and raise up seed unto his brother. ²⁰ Now there were seven *brethren*: and the first took a wife, and dying left no seed.

Mark 13:12

Now the *brother* shall betray the *brother* to death, and the father the son; and children shall rise up against their parents, and shall cause them to be put to death.

Luke 3:1

Now in the fifteenth year of the reign of Tiberius Caesar, Pontius Pilate being governor of Judaea, and Herod being tetrarch of Galilee, and his *brother* Philip tetrarch of Ituraea and of the region of Trachonitis, and Lysanias the tetrarch of Abilene,

Luke 3:19

But Herod the tetrarch, being reproved by him for Herodias his *brother* Philip's wife, and for all the evils which Herod had done,

Luke 6:14

Simon, (whom he also named Peter,) and Andrew his *brother*, James and John, Philip and Bartholomew,

Luke 6:41-42

And why beholdest thou the mote that is in thy *brother's* eye, but perceivest not the beam that is in thine own eye? ⁴² Either how canst thou say to thy *brother, Brother*, let me pull out the mote that is in thine eye, when thou thyself beholdest not the beam that is in thine own eye? Thou hypocrite, cast out first the beam out of thine own eye, and then shalt thou see clearly to pull out the mote that is in thy *brother's* eye.

Luke 8:19-21

Then came to him his mother and his *brethren*, and could not come at him for the press. ²⁰ And it was told him by certain which said, Thy mother and thy *brethren* stand without, desiring to see thee. ²¹ And he answered and said unto them, My mother and my *brethren* are these which hear the word of God, and do it.

Luke 12:13

And one of the company said unto him, Master, speak to my *brother*, that he divide the inheritance with me.

Luke 14:12

Then said he also to him that bade him, When thou makest a dinner or a supper, call not thy friends, nor thy *brethren*, neither thy kinsmen, nor thy rich neighbours; lest they also bid thee again, and a recompence be made thee.

Luke 14:26

If any man come to me, and hate not his father, and mother, and wife, and children, and *brethren*, and sisters, yea, and his own life also, he cannot be my disciple.

Luke 15:27

And he said unto him, Thy *brother* is come; and thy father hath killed the fatted calf, because he hath received him safe and sound.

Luke 15:32

It was meet that we should make merry, and be glad: for this thy *brother* was dead, and is alive again; and was lost, and is found.

Luke 16:28

For I have five *brethren*; that he may testify unto them, lest they also come into this place of torment.

Luke 17:3

Take heed to yourselves: If thy *brother* trespass against thee, rebuke him; and if he repent, forgive him.

Luke 18:29

And he said unto them, Verily I say unto you, There is no man that hath left house, or parents, or *brethren*, or wife, or children, for the kingdom of God's sake,

Luke 20:28-29

Saying, Master, Moses wrote unto us, If any man's **brother** die, having a wife, and he die without children, that his **brother** should take his wife, and raise up seed unto his **brother**. ²⁹ There were therefore seven **brethren**: and the first took a wife, and died without children.

Luke 21:16

And ye shall be betrayed both by parents, and *brethren*, and kinsfolks, and friends; and some of you shall they cause to be put to death.

Luke 22:32

But I have prayed for thee, that thy faith fail not: and when thou art converted, strengthen thy *brethren*.

John 1:40-41

One of the two which heard John speak, and followed him, was Andrew, Simon Peter's **brother**. ⁴¹ He first findeth his own **brother** Simon, and saith unto him, We have found the Messias, which is, being interpreted, the Christ.

John 2:12

After this he went down to Capernaum, he, and his mother, and his *brethren*, and his disciples: and they continued there not many days.

John 6:8

One of his disciples, Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, saith unto him,

John 7:3

His *brethren* therefore said unto him, Depart hence, and go into Judaea, that thy disciples also may see the works that thou doest.

John 7:5

For neither did his *brethren* believe in him.

John 7:10

But when his *brethren* were gone up, then went he also up unto the feast, not openly, but as it were in secret.

John 11:2

(It was that Mary which anointed the Lord with ointment, and wiped his feet with her hair, whose *brother* Lazarus was sick.)

John 11:19

And many of the Jews came to Martha and Mary, to comfort them concerning their brother.

John 11:21

Then said Martha unto Jesus, Lord, if thou hadst been here, my *brother* had not died.

John 11:23

Jesus saith unto her, Thy *brother* shall rise again.

John 11:32

Then when Mary was come where Jesus was, and saw him, she fell down at his feet, saying unto him, Lord, if thou hadst been here, my *brother* had not died.

John 20:17

Jesus saith unto her, Touch me not; for I am not yet ascended to my Father: but go to my *brethren*, and say unto them, I ascend unto my Father, and your Father; and to my God, and your God.

John 21:23

Then went this saying abroad among the *brethren*, that that disciple should not die: yet Jesus said not unto him, He shall not die; but, If I will that he tarry till I come, what is that to thee?

Acts 1:14-16

These all continued with one accord in prayer and supplication, with the women, and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with his *brethren.* ¹⁵ And in those days Peter stood up in the midst of the *disciples*, and said, (the number of names together were about an hundred and twenty,) ¹⁶ Men and *brethren*, this scripture must needs have been fulfilled, which the Holy Ghost by the mouth of David spake before concerning Judas, which was guide to them that took Jesus.

Acts 2:29

Men and *brethren*, let me freely speak unto you of the patriarch David, that he is both dead and buried, and his sepulchre is with us unto this day.

Acts 2:37

Now when they heard this, they were pricked in their heart, and said unto Peter and to the rest of the apostles, Men and *brethren*, what shall we do?

Acts 3:17

And now, *brethren*, I wot that through ignorance ye did it, as did also your rulers.

Acts 3:22

For Moses truly said unto the fathers, A prophet shall the Lord your God raise up unto you of your *brethren*, like unto me; him shall ye hear in all things whatsoever he shall say unto you.

Acts 6:3

Wherefore, *brethren,* look ye out among you seven men of honest report, full of the Holy Ghost and wisdom, whom we may appoint over this business.

Acts 7:2

And he said, Men, *brethren*, and fathers, hearken; The God of glory appeared unto our father Abraham, when he was in Mesopotamia, before he dwelt in Charran,

Acts 7:13

And at the second time Joseph was made known to his *brethren*; and Joseph's kindred was made known unto Pharaoh.

Acts 7:23

And when he was full forty years old, it came into his heart to visit his *brethren* the children of Israel.

Acts 7:25-26

For he supposed his *brethren* would have understood how that God by his hand would deliver them: but they understood not. ²⁶ And the next day he shewed himself unto them as they strove, and would have set them at one again, saying, Sirs, ye are *brethren*; why do ye wrong one to another?

Acts 7:37

This is that Moses, which said unto the children of Israel, A prophet shall the Lord your God raise up unto you of your *brethren*, like unto me; him shall ye hear.

Acts 9:17

And Ananias went his way, and entered into the house; and putting his hands on him said, *Brother* Saul, the Lord, even Jesus, that appeared unto thee in the way as thou camest, hath sent me, that thou mightest receive thy sight, and be filled with the Holy Ghost.

Acts 9:30

Which when the *brethren* knew, they brought him down to Caesarea, and sent him forth to Tarsus.

Acts 10:23

Then called he them in, and lodged them. And on the morrow Peter went away with them, and certain *brethren* from Joppa accompanied him.

Acts 11:1

And the apostles and *brethren* that were in Judaea heard that the Gentiles had also received the word of God.

Acts 11:12

And the spirit bade me go with them, nothing doubting. Moreover these six *brethren* accompanied me, and we entered into the man's house:

Acts 11:29

Then the disciples, every man according to his ability, determined to send relief unto the *brethren* which dwelt in Judaea:

Acts 12:2

And he killed James the *brother* of John with the sword.

Acts 12:17

But he, beckoning unto them with the hand to hold their peace, declared unto them how the Lord had brought him out of the prison. And he said, Go shew these things unto James, and to the *brethren.* And he departed, and went into another place.

Acts 13:15

And after the reading of the law and the prophets the rulers of the synagogue sent unto them, saying, Ye men and *brethren*, if ye have any word of exhortation for the people, say on.

Acts 13:26

Men and *brethren*, children of the stock of Abraham, and whosoever among you feareth God, to you is the word of this salvation sent.

Acts 13:38

Be it known unto you therefore, men and *brethren*, that through this man is preached unto you the forgiveness of sins:

Acts 14:2

But the unbelieving Jews stirred up the Gentiles, and made their minds evil affected against the *brethren*.

Acts 15:1

And certain men which came down from Judaea taught the *brethren,* and said, Except ye be circumcised after the manner of Moses, ye cannot be saved.

Acts 15:3

And being brought on their way by the church, they passed through Phenice and Samaria, declaring the conversion of the Gentiles: and they caused great joy unto all the *brethren*.

Acts 15:7

And when there had been much disputing, Peter rose up, and said unto them, Men and *brethren*, ye know how that a good while ago God made choice among us, that the Gentiles by my mouth should hear the word of the gospel, and believe.

Acts 15:13

And after they had held their peace, James answered, saying, Men and *brethren*, hearken unto me:

Acts 15:22-23

Then pleased it the apostles and elders, with the whole church, to send chosen men of their own company to Antioch with Paul and Barnabas; namely, Judas surnamed Barsabas, and Silas, chief men among the *brethren:* ²³ And they wrote letters by them after this manner; The apostles and elders and *brethren* send greeting unto the *brethren* which are of the Gentiles in Antioch and Syria and Cilicia:

Acts 15:32-33

And Judas and Silas, being prophets also themselves, exhorted the *brethren* with many words, and confirmed them. ³³ And after they had tarried there a space, they were let go in peace from the *brethren* unto the apostles.

Acts 15:36

And some days after Paul said unto Barnabas, Let us go again and visit our *brethren* in every city where we have preached the word of the Lord, and see how they do.

Acts 15:40

And Paul chose Silas, and departed, being recommended by the *brethren* unto the grace of God.

Acts 16:2

Which was well reported of by the *brethren* that were at Lystra and Iconium.

Acts 16:40

And they went out of the prison, and entered into the house of Lydia and when they had seen the *brethren*, they comforted them, and departed.

Acts 17:6

And when they found them not, they drew Jason and certain *brethren* unto the rulers of the city, crying, These that have turned the world upside down are come hither also;

Acts 17:10

And the *brethren* immediately sent away Paul and Silas by night unto Berea: who coming thither went into the synagogue of the Jews.

Acts 17:14

And then immediately the *brethren* sent away Paul to go as it were to the sea: but Silas and Timotheus abode there still.

Acts 18:18

And Paul after this tarried there yet a good while, and then took his leave of the *brethren*, and sailed thence into Syria, and with him Priscilla and Aquila; having shorn his head in Cenchrea: for he had a vow.

Acts 18:27

And when he was disposed to pass into Achaia, the *brethren* wrote, exhorting the disciples to receive him: who, when he was come, helped them much which had believed through grace:

Acts 21:7

And when we had finished our course from Tyre, we came to Ptolemais, and saluted the *brethren*, and abode with them one day.

Acts 21:17

And when we were come to Jerusalem, the *brethren* received us gladly.

Acts 21:20

And when they heard it, they glorified the Lord, and said unto him, Thou seest, *brother*, how many thousands of Jews there are which believe; and they are all zealous of the law:

Acts 22:1

Men, *brethren*, and fathers, hear ye my defence which I make now unto you.

Acts 22:5

As also the high priest doth bear me witness, and all the estate of the elders: from whom also I received letters unto the *brethren*, and went to Damascus, to bring them which were there bound unto Jerusalem, for to be punished.

Acts 22:13

Came unto me, and stood, and said unto me, *Brother* Saul, receive thy sight. And the same hour I looked up upon him.

Acts 23:1

And Paul, earnestly beholding the council, said, Men and *brethren*, I have lived in all good conscience before God until this day.

Acts 23:5-6

Then said Paul, I wist not, *brethren*, that he was the high priest: for it is written, Thou shalt not speak evil of the ruler of thy people. ⁶ But when Paul perceived that the one part were Sadducees, and the other Pharisees, he cried out in the council, Men and *brethren*, I am a Pharisee, the son of a Pharisee: of the hope and resurrection of the dead I am called in question.

Acts 28:14-15

Where we found *brethren*, and were desired to tarry with them seven days: and so we went toward Rome. ¹⁵ And from thence, when the *brethren* heard of us, they came to meet us as far as Appii forum, and The three taverns: whom when Paul saw, he thanked God, and took courage.

Acts 28:17

And it came to pass, that after three days Paul called the chief of the Jews together: and when they were come together, he said unto them, Men and *brethren*, though I have committed nothing against the people, or customs of our fathers, yet was I delivered prisoner from Jerusalem into the hands of the Romans.

Acts 28:21

And they said unto him, We neither received letters out of Judaea concerning thee, neither any of the *brethren* that came shewed or spake any harm of thee.

Romans 1:13

Now I would not have you ignorant, *brethren*, that oftentimes I purposed to come unto you, (but was let hitherto,) that I might have some fruit among you also, even as among other Gentiles.

Romans 7:1

Know ye not, *brethren*, (for I speak to them that know the law,) how that the law hath dominion over a man as long as he liveth?

Romans 7:4

Wherefore, my *brethren*, ye also are become dead to the law by the body of Christ; that ye should be married to another, even to him who is raised from the dead, that we should bring forth fruit unto God.

Romans 8:12

Therefore, *brethren*, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live after the flesh.

Romans 8:29

For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many *brethren*.

Romans 9:3

For I could wish that myself were accursed from Christ for my *brethren,* my kinsmen according to the flesh:

Romans 10:1

Brethren, my heart's desire and prayer to God for Israel is, that they might be saved.

Romans 11:25

For I would not, *brethren*, that ye should be ignorant of this mystery, lest ye should be wise in your own conceits; that blindness in part is happened to Israel, until the fulness of the Gentiles be come in.

Romans 12:1

I beseech you therefore, *brethren*, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.

Romans 14:10

But why dost thou judge thy *brother*? or why dost thou set at nought thy *brother*? for we shall all stand before the judgment seat of Christ.

Romans 14:13

Let us not therefore judge one another any more: but judge this rather, that no man put a stumblingblock or an occasion to fall in his *brother's* way.

Romans 14:15

But if thy *brother* be grieved with thy meat, now walkest thou not charitably. Destroy not him with thy meat, for whom Christ died.

Romans 14:21

It is good neither to eat flesh, nor to drink wine, nor any thing whereby thy *brother* stumbleth, or is offended, or is made weak.

Romans 15:14

And I myself also am persuaded of you, my *brethren*, that ye also are full of goodness, filled with all knowledge, able also to admonish one another.

Romans 15:30

Now I beseech you, *brethren,* for the Lord Jesus Christ's sake, and for the love of the Spirit, that ye strive together with me in your prayers to God for me;

Romans 16:14

Salute Asyncritus, Phlegon, Hermas, Patrobas, Hermes, and the *brethren* which are with them.

Romans 16:17

Now I beseech you, *brethren*, mark them which cause divisions and offences contrary to the doctrine which ye have learned; and avoid them.

Romans 16:23

Gaius mine host, and of the whole church, saluteth you. Erastus the chamberlain of the city saluteth you, and Quartus a *brother*.

I Corinthians 1:1

Paul, called to be an apostle of Jesus Christ through the will of God, and Sosthenes our *brother*,

I Corinthians 1:10-11

Now I beseech you, *brethren*, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you; but that ye be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment. ¹¹ For it hath been declared unto me of you, my *brethren*, by them which are of the house of Chloe, that there are contentions among you.

I Corinthians 1:26

For ye see your calling, *brethren*, how that not many wise men after the flesh, not many mighty, not many noble, are called:

I Corinthians 2:1

And I, *brethren*, when I came to you, came not with excellency of speech or of wisdom, declaring unto you the testimony of God.

I Corinthians 3:1

And I, *brethren*, could not speak unto you as unto spiritual, but as unto carnal, even as unto babes in Christ.

I Corinthians 4:6

And these things, *brethren,* I have in a figure transferred to myself and to Apollos for your sakes; that ye might learn in us not to think of men above that which is written, that no one of you be puffed up for one against another.

I Corinthians 5:11

But now I have written unto you not to keep company, if any man that is called *a brother* be a fornicator, or covetous, or an idolater, or a railer, or a drunkard, or an extortioner; with such an one no not to eat.

I Corinthians 6:5-6

I speak to your shame. Is it so, that there is not a wise man among you? no, not one that shall be able to judge between his *brethren*? ⁶ But brother goeth to law with *brother*, and that before the unbelievers.

I Corinthians 6:8

Nay, ye do wrong, and defraud, and that your brethren.

I Corinthians 7:12

But to the rest speak I, not the Lord: If any *brother* hath a wife that believeth not, and she be pleased to dwell with him, let him not put her away.

I Corinthians 7:14-15

For the unbelieving husband is sanctified by the wife, and the unbelieving wife is sanctified by the *husband*: else were your children unclean; but now are they holy. ¹⁵ But if the unbelieving depart, let him depart. *A brother* or a sister is not under bondage in such cases: but God hath called us to peace.

I Corinthians 7:24

Brethren, let every man, wherein he is called, therein abide with God.

I Corinthians 7:29

But this I say, *brethren*, the time is short: it remaineth, that both they that have wives be as though they had none;

I Corinthians 8:11-13

And through thy knowledge shall the weak *brother* perish, for whom Christ died? ¹² But when ye sin so against the *brethren*, and wound their weak conscience, ye sin against Christ. ¹³ Wherefore, if meat make my *brother* to offend, I will eat no flesh while the world standeth, lest I make my *brother* to offend.

I Corinthians 9:5

Have we not power to lead about a sister, a wife, as well as other apostles, and as the *brethren* of the Lord, and Cephas?

I Corinthians 10:1

Moreover, *brethren*, I would not that ye should be ignorant, how that all our fathers were under the cloud, and all passed through the sea;

I Corinthians 11:33

Wherefore, my *brethren*, when ye come together to eat, tarry one for another.

I Corinthians 12:1

Now concerning spiritual gifts, *brethren*, I would not have you ignorant.

I Corinthians 14:6

Now, *brethren*, if I come unto you speaking with tongues, what shall I profit you, except I shall speak to you either by revelation, or by knowledge, or by prophesying, or by doctrine?

I Corinthians 14:20

Brethren, be not children in understanding: howbeit in malice be ye children, but in understanding be men.

I Corinthians 14:26

How is it then, *brethren*? when ye come together, every one of you hath a psalm, hath a doctrine, hath a tongue, hath a revelation, hath an interpretation. Let all things be done unto edifying.

I Corinthians 14:39

Wherefore, *brethren*, covet to prophesy, and forbid not to speak with tongues.

I Corinthians 15:1

Moreover, *brethren*, I declare unto you the gospel which I preached unto you, which also ye have received, and wherein ye stand;

I Corinthians 15:6

After that, he was seen of above five hundred *brethren* at once; of whom the greater part remain unto this present, but some are fallen asleep.

I Corinthians 15:50

Now this I say, *brethren*, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; neither doth corruption inherit incorruption.

I Corinthians 15:58

Therefore, my beloved *brethren*, be ye stedfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in vain in the Lord.

I Corinthians 16:11-12

Let no man therefore despise him: but conduct him forth in peace, that he may come unto me: for I look for him with the *brethren*. ¹² As touching our brother Apollos, I greatly desired him to come unto you with the *brethren*: but his will was not at all to come at this time; but he will come when he shall have convenient time.

I Corinthians 16:15

I beseech you, *brethren,* (ye know the house of Stephanas, that it is the firstfruits of Achaia, and that they have addicted themselves to the ministry of the saints,)

I Corinthians 16:20

All the *brethren* greet you. Greet ye one another with an holy kiss.

II Corinthians 1:1

Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God, and Timothy our *brother*, unto the church of God which is at Corinth, with all the saints which are in all Achaia:

II Corinthians 1:8

For we would not, *brethren*, have you ignorant of our trouble which came to us in Asia, that we were pressed out of measure, above strength, insomuch that we despaired even of life:

II Corinthians 2:13

I had no rest in my spirit, because I found not Titus my *brother*: but taking my leave of them, I went from thence into Macedonia.

II Corinthians 8:1

Moreover, *brethren*, we do you to wit of the grace of God bestowed on the churches of Macedonia;

II Corinthians 8:18

And we have sent with him the *brother*, whose praise is in the gospel throughout all the churches;

II Corinthians 8:22-23

And we have sent with them our **brother**, whom we have oftentimes proved diligent in many things, but now much more diligent, upon the great confidence which I have in you. ²³ Whether any do inquire of Titus, he is my partner and fellowhelper concerning you: or our **brethren** be inquired of, they are the messengers of the churches, and the glory of Christ.

II Corinthians 9:3

Yet have I sent the *brethren*, lest our boasting of you should be in vain in this behalf; that, as I said, ye may be ready:

II Corinthians 9:5

Therefore I thought it necessary to exhort the *brethren*, that they would go before unto you, and make up beforehand your bounty, whereof ye had notice before, that the same might be ready, as a matter of bounty, and not as of covetousness.

II Corinthians 11:9

And when I was present with you, and wanted, I was chargeable to no man: for that which was lacking to me the *brethren* which came from Macedonia supplied: and in all things I have kept myself from being burdensome unto you, and so will I keep myself.

II Corinthians 12:18

I desired Titus, and with him I sent a *brother*. Did Titus make a gain of you? walked we not in the same spirit? walked we not in the same steps?

II Corinthians 13:11

Finally, *brethren,* farewell. Be perfect, be of good comfort, be of one mind, live in peace; and the God of love and peace shall be with you.

Galatians 1:2

And all the *brethren* which are with me, unto the churches of Galatia:

Galatians 1:11

But I certify you, *brethren*, that the gospel which was preached of me is not after man.

Galatians 1:19

But other of the apostles saw I none, save James the Lord's brother.

Galatians 3:15

Brethren, I speak after the manner of men; Though it be but a man's covenant, yet if it be confirmed, no man disannulleth, or addeth thereto.

Galatians 4:12

Brethren, I beseech you, be as I am; for I am as ye are: ye have not injured me at all.

Galatians 4:28

Now we, *brethren*, as Isaac was, are the children of promise.

Galatians 4:31

So then, *brethren*, we are not children of the bondwoman, but of the free.

Galatians 5:11

And I, *brethren*, if I yet preach circumcision, why do I yet suffer persecution? then is the offence of the cross ceased.

Galatians 5:13

For, *brethren*, ye have been called unto liberty; only use not liberty for an occasion to the flesh, but by love serve one another.

Galatians 6:1

Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, restore such an one in the spirit of meekness; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted.

Galatians 6:18

Brethren, the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with your spirit. Amen.

Ephesians 6:21

But that ye also may know my affairs, and how I do, Tychicus, a *beloved* brother and faithful minister in the Lord, shall make known to you all things:

Ephesians 6:23

Peace be to the *brethren*, and love with faith, from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

Philippians 1:12

But I would ye should understand, *brethren*, that the things which happened unto me have fallen out rather unto the furtherance of the gospel;

Philippians 1:14

And many of the *brethren* in the Lord, waxing confident by my bonds, are much more bold to speak the word without fear.

Philippians 2:25

Yet I supposed it necessary to send to you Epaphroditus, my *brother*, and companion in labour, and fellowsoldier, but your messenger, and he that ministered to my wants.

Philippians 3:1

Finally, my *brethren*, rejoice in the Lord. To write the same things to you, to me indeed is not grievous, but for you it is safe.

Philippians 3:13

Brethren, I count not myself to have apprehended: but this one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind, and reaching forth unto those things which are before,

Philippians 3:17

Brethren, be followers together of me, and mark them which walk so as ye have us for an ensample.

Vine's Expository Dictionary of Biblical Words

Brother - Hebrew

BROTHER

°ach "brother." This word has cognates in Ugaritic and most other Semitic languages. Biblical Hebrew attests the word about 629 times and at all periods.

In its basic meaning, **°ach** represents a "male sibling," a "brother." This is its meaning in the first biblical appearance: "And she again bare his brother Abel" Gen 4:2. This word represents a full brother or a half-brother: "And he said to him, Go, I pray thee, see whether it be well with thy brethren..." Gen 37:14.

In another nuance, **°ach** can represent a "blood relative." Abram's nephew is termed his "brother": "And he brought back all the goods, and also brought again his brother Lot, and his goods, and the women also, and the people" Gen 14:16. This passage, however, might also reflect the covenantal use of the term whereby it connotes "ally" (cf. Gen 13:8). In Gen 9:25, **°ach** clearly signifies "relative": "Cursed be Canaan; a servant of servants shall he be unto his brethren." Laban called his cousin Jacob an **°ach**: "And Laban said unto Jacob, Because thou art my brother, shouldest thou therefore serve me for nought?" Gen 29:15. Just before this, Jacob described himself as an **°ach** of Rachel's father Gen 29:12. Tribes may be called **°achim**: "And [the tribe of] Judah said unto [the tribe of] Simeon his brother, Come up with me into my lot..." Judg 1:3. The word **°ach** is used of a fellow tribesman: "With whomsoever thou findest thy gods, let him not live: before our brethren discern thou what is thine..." Gen 31:32. Elsewhere it describes a fellow countryman: "And it came to pass in those days, when Moses was grown, that he went out unto his brethren, and looked on their burdens..." Ex 2:11.

In several passages, the word **°ach** connotes "companion" or "colleague" — that is, a brother by choice. One example is found in II Kings 9:2: "And when thou comest thither, look out there Jehu the son of Jehoshaphat the son of Nimshi, and go in, and make him arise up from among his brethren, and carry him to an inner chamber" (cf. Isa 41:6; Num 8:26). Somewhat along this line is the covenantal use of the word as a synonym for "ally": "And Lot went out at the door unto them, and shut the door after him, and said, I pray you, brethren, do not so wickedly" Gen 19:6-7. Notice this same use in Num 20:14 and I Kings 9:13.

°Ach can be a term of polite address, as it appears to be in Gen 29:4: "And Jacob said unto them [shepherds, whose identity he did not know], My brethren, whence be ye?"

The word **°ach** sometimes represents someone or something that simply exists alongside a given person or thing: "And surely your blood of your lives will I require; at the hand of every beast will I require it, and at the hand of... every man's brother will I require the life of man" Gen 9:5-6.

With "men" (**aner**, "male"), prefixed, it is used in addresses only, Acts 2:29,37, etc.; (5) any man, a neighbor, Luke 10:29; Matt 5:22; 7:3; (6) persons united by a common interest, Matt 5:47; (7) persons united by a common calling, Rev 22:9; (8) mankind, Matt 25:40; Heb 2:17; (9) the disciples, and so, by implication, all believers, Matt 28:10; John 20:17; (10) believers, apart from sex, Matt 23:8; Acts 1:15; Rom 1:13; 1 Thess 1:4; Rev 19:10 (the word "sisters" is used of believers, only in 1 Tim 5:2); (11) believers, with **aner**, "male," prefixed, and with "or sister" added, 1 Cor 7:14 (RV), 15; 15, male as distinct from female, Acts 1:16; 15:7,13, but not 6:3.
