THE GOAL IS ANGER RESOLUTION *NOT* ANGER MANAGEMENT

This teaching expresses various perspectives on Anger and specifically narrows it down to 10 progressive levels of Anger. Additionally, it reflects on the difference between Anger and Wrath.

Insights Into an Angry Man's Life

Today the trend is for anger management, however we are told in scripture to have anger resolution (i.e.) to put off.

Colossians 3:8

But now ye also **put off** all these; *anger, wrath*, malice, blasphemy, filthy communication out of your mouth.

Ephesians 4:31

Let all bitterness, and *wrath*, and *anger*, and clamour, and evil speaking, be **put away** from you, with all malice:

Matthew 5:22

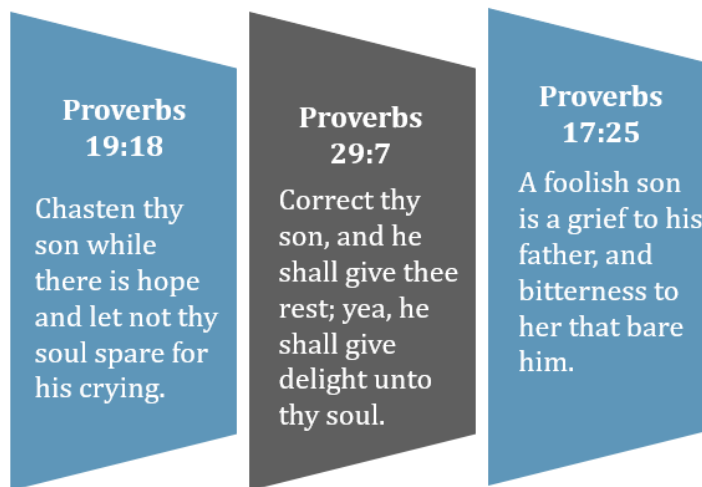
But I say unto you, that whosoever is *angry* with his brother without a cause shall be in danger of the judgment: and whosoever shall say to his brother, Raca, shall be in danger of the council: but whosoever shall say, Thou fool, shall be in danger of hell fire.

Insights into an Angry Man's Life

As the person grows into an adult there is at times an over discipline or under discipline. This plus picking up some of our parent's traits and "the nature all are born with" is a combination that can start a person on the road to being an **angry** person.



If there were a national crisis today it would be angry men and impatient women. As this person grows into an adult, he seeks **attention, acceptance, and acknowledgement**. To the degree this is not received is the degree of frustration.

Therefore one finds various ways to get **attention, acceptance,** and **acknowledgement**. It can be by being foolish, mean, or wise in one's own conceit, and other various ways. This works for a while but there soon comes a "reaction" from other people which in turn also brings a reaction. Slowly the ropes are tying the person in stubbornness.

I Samuel 15:23

For rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft, and stubbornness is as **iniquity** and idolatry. Because thou hast rejected the word of the LORD, he hath also rejected thee from being king.) This reaction leads a person to resist instruction.

Proverbs 1:30

They would none of my counsel: they despised all my reproof.

Proverbs 5:12

And say, How have I hated instruction, and my heart despised reproof;) This is all on the path to being an **angry** person.

There are progressive levels of iniquity and related levels of fools which shows how this person goes through reactions. Occasionally they learn how to quell the **anger** and at times are passive aggressive.

The early stages put them at odds with authority.

Proverbs 15:5

A fool despiseth his father's instruction: but he that regardeth reproof is prudent.

Proverbs 16:14

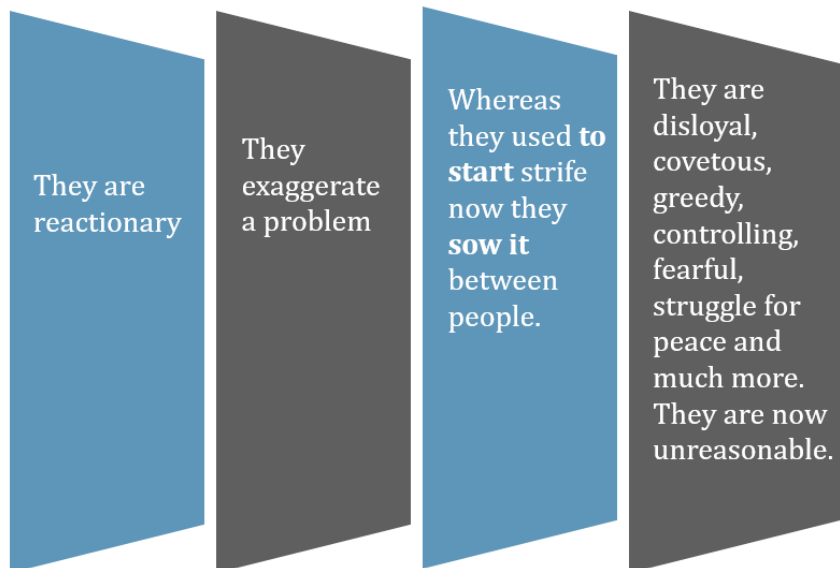
The wrath of a king is as messengers of death: but a wise man will pacify it.

As stubbornness develops in their life it shows up in visible ways:



Proverbs 16:28

A froward man soweth strife: and a whisperer separateth chief friends. **(Forward equals unreasonable.)**

Proverbs 27:4

Wrath is cruel, and **anger** is outrageous; but who is able to stand before envy?

Proverbs 15:1

A soft answer turneth away **wrath**: but grievous words stir up **anger**.

Proverbs 15:18

A **wrathful** man stirreth up strife: but he that is slow to **anger** appeaseth strife.

Proverbs 16:32

He that is slow to **anger** is better than the mighty; and he that ruleth his spirit than he that taketh a city.

Proverbs 19:11

The discretion of a man deferreth his **anger**; and it is his glory to pass over a transgression.

When a person is in this stage, problems start to develop.

At first the person struggles with authority, and they kindle strife.

Proverbs 26:21

As coals are to burning coals, and wood to fire; so is a contentious man to kindle strife.

However, in this stage they **sow strife**. The result is that their stubbornness leads this person to make poor financial decisions. **They may be successful for some time** but grow to **distrust people** and they **want to get their way**. It is difficult to reason with them and ironically, they gather bad council around themselves. Their focus on control draws them to added mistakes.

Proverbs 14:17

He that is soon **angry** dealeth foolishly: and a man of wicked devices is hated.) **Here they are fearful and disloyal.**

Insights into an Angry Man's Life

Then a person enters yet a greater level of **anger**. So much that they may have a tough time sleeping.

Proverbs 22:8

He that soweth iniquity shall reap vanity: and the rod of his **anger** shall fail.

Proverbs 29:22

An **angry** man **stirreth up** strife, and a **furious** man aboundeth in transgression.

In the previous level, a person **sows strife**.

In this level, a person **stirs up strife** (Body, soul, and spirit).

If a person does not address this issue, it will get worse into yet another level. Although **anger** is different than **wrath** there is an ironic issue.

First as an issue on it's own it is possible to struggle with **wrath** and express **wrath**. It may look like **anger** but may not be. (See the teaching on **Wrath**.) Then on yet another separate issue it is possible to struggle with **anger** and go through phases on the way to **wrath**. Here are insights on the transition:

The below shows **anger** and **wrath** as different yet related:

Deuteronomy 9:19

For I was afraid of the **anger** and hot displeasure, wherewith the LORD WAS wroth against you to destroy you. But the LORD hearkened unto me at that time also.

Deuteronomy 29:28

And the LORD rooted them out of their land in **anger**, and in **wrath**, and in great indignation, and cast them into another land, as it is this day.

Psalms 6:1

O LORD, rebuke me not in thine **anger**, neither chasten me in thy hot displeasure.

Psalms 90:7

For we are consumed by thine **anger**, and by thy **wrath** are we troubled.

Jeremiah 21:5

And I myself will fight against you with an outstretched hand and with a strong arm, even in **anger**, and in **fury**, and in great **wrath**.

Insights into an Angry Man's Life

If a person refuses to do right and continues in **anger** (hiding it on occasion), many times this leads the person to a crisis of anger and into wrath. His **anger** many times leads to physical problems and serious destruction in people. **This is a real crisis.** This in turn can lead to doctors and other medical attempts to solve the problem which are not the root cause. There is an “**End**” visible sign. Sooner or later, almost all those a wrathful person deals with are “cut off”. Listed below are verses pertaining to this difficult stage. See also the teaching on **wrath** for the **7 physical medical stages**. This stage of moving into **wrath** is terrible.

Psalms 55:3

Because of the voice of the enemy, because of the oppression of the wicked: for they cast iniquity upon me, and in **wrath** they hate me.

Psalms 37:8

Cease from **anger**, and forsake **wrath**: fret not thyself in any wise to do evil.

Proverbs 19:19

A man of great **wrath** shall suffer punishment: for if thou deliver him, yet thou must do it again.

Proverbs 12:16

A fool's **wrath** is presently known: but a prudent man covereth shame.

Proverbs 27:3

A stone is heavy, and the sand weighty; but a fool's **wrath** is heavier than them both.

Proverbs 11:4

Riches profit not in the day of **wrath**: but righteousness delivereth from death.

Proverbs 11:23

The desire of the righteous is only good: but the expectation of the wicked is **wrath**.

Proverbs 21:24

Proud and haughty scorner is his name, who dealeth in proud **wrath**.

Genesis 2:7

And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed **into his nostrils** the breath of life; and man became a living soul.

Genesis 3:19

In the sweat of **thy face** shalt thou eat bread, till thou return unto the ground; for out of it wast thou taken: for dust thou art, and unto dust shalt thou return.

Genesis 7:22

All **in** whose **nostrils** was the breath of life, of all that was in the dry land, died.

Genesis 19:1

And there came two angels to Sodom at even; and Lot sat in the gate of Sodom: and Lot seeing them rose up to meet them; and he bowed himself with **his face** toward the ground;

Genesis 24:47

And I asked her, and said, Whose daughter art thou? And she said, The daughter of Bethuel, Nahor's son, whom Milcah bare unto him: and I put the earring upon **her face**, and the bracelets upon her hands.

So Jonathan arose from the table in fierce *anger*, and did eat no meat the second day of the month: for he was grieved for David, because his father had done him shame.

I Samuel 20:41

And as soon as the lad was gone, David arose out of a place toward the south, and fell *on his face* to the ground, and bowed himself three times: and they kissed one another, and wept one with another, until David exceeded.

I Samuel 24:8

David also arose afterward, and went out of the cave, and cried after Saul, saying, My lord the king. And when Saul looked behind him, David stooped with *his face to* the earth, and bowed himself.

I Samuel 25:23

And when Abigail saw David, she hasted, and lighted off the ass, and fell *before* David on her face, and bowed herself to the ground,

Psalms 103:8

The LORD is merciful and gracious, slow to *anger*, and plenteous in mercy.

Therefore was *the wrath of* the LORD kindled against his people, insomuch that he abhorred his own inheritance.

Psalms 110:5

The Lord at thy right hand shall strike through kings in the day of *his wrath*.

Jeremiah 32:37

Behold, I will gather them out of all countries, whither I have driven them *in mine anger*, and in my fury, and in great wrath; and I will bring them again unto this place, and I will cause them to dwell safely:

Jeremiah 44:6

Wherefore my fury *and mine anger* was poured forth, and was kindled in the cities of Judah and in the streets of Jerusalem; and they are wasted and desolate, as at this day.

Jeremiah 49:37

For I will cause Elam to be dismayed before their enemies, and before them that seek their life: and I will bring evil upon them even *my fierce anger*, saith the LORD; and I will send the sword after them, till I have consumed them:

Jeremiah 51:45

My people, go ye out of the midst of her, and deliver ye every man his soul from the fierce *anger of* the LORD.

Jeremiah 52:3

For through *the anger of* the LORD it came to pass in Jerusalem and Judah, till he had cast them out from his presence, that Zedekiah rebelled against the king of Babylon.

Lamentations 1:12

Is it nothing to you, all ye that pass by? behold, and see if there be any sorrow like unto my sorrow, which is done unto me, wherewith the LORD hath afflicted me in the day of *his fierce anger*.

Lamentations 2:1

How hath the Lord covered the daughter of Zion with a cloud *in his anger*, and cast down from heaven unto the earth the beauty of Israel, and remembered not his footstool in the day of his anger!

Lamentations 2:3

He hath cut off in his fierce *anger* all the horn of Israel: he hath drawn back his right hand from before the enemy, and he burned against Jacob like a flaming fire, which devoureth round about.

And he hath violently taken away his tabernacle, as if it were of a garden: he hath destroyed his places of the assembly: the LORD hath caused the solemn feasts and sabbaths to be forgotten in Zion, and hath despised in the indignation of *his anger* the king and the priest.

Lamentations 2:21-22

The young and the old lie on the ground in the streets: my virgins and my young men are fallen by the sword; thou hast slain them in the day of *thine anger*; thou hast killed, and not pitied. 22. Thou hast called as in a solemn day my terrors round about, so that in the day of the LORD's *anger* none escaped nor remained: those that I have swaddled and brought up hath mine enemy consumed.

Lamentations 3:43

Thou hast covered *with anger*, and persecuted us: thou hast slain, thou hast not pitied.

Lamentations 3:66

Persecute and destroy them *in anger* from under the heavens of the LORD.

Lamentations 4:11

The LORD hath accomplished his fury; he hath poured out *his* fierce *anger*, and hath kindled a fire in Zion, and it hath devoured the foundations thereof.

Lamentations 4:20

The breath of *our nostrils*, the anointed of the LORD, was taken in their pits, of whom we said, Under his shadow we shall live among the heathen.

Ezekiel 5:13

Thus shall *mine anger* be accomplished, and I will cause my fury to rest upon them, and I will be comforted: and they shall know that I the LORD have spoken it in my zeal, when I have accomplished my fury in them.

Ezekiel 5:15

So it shall be a reproach and a taunt, an instruction and an astonishment unto the nations that are round about thee, when I shall execute judgments in thee *in anger* and in fury and in furious rebukes. I the LORD have spoken it.

Daniel 11:20

Then shall stand up in his estate a raiser of taxes in the glory of the kingdom: but within few days he shall be destroyed, neither *in anger*, nor in battle.

Hosea 8:5

Thy calf, O Samaria, hath cast thee off; *mine anger* is kindled against them: how long will it be ere they attain to innocency?

Hosea 11:9

I will not execute the fierceness of *mine anger*, I will not return to destroy Ephraim: for I am God, and not man; the Holy One in the midst of thee: and I will not enter into the city.

Hosea 13:11

I gave thee a king *in mine anger*, and took him away in my wrath.

ka`ac (kaw-as') to trouble; by implication, to grieve, rage, be indignant:

ANGER, BURNING

A. Verb.

charah "to get angry, be angry." This verb appears in the Bible 92 times. In the basic stem, the word refers to the "burning of anger" as in Jonah 4:1. In the causative stem, **charah** means "to become heated with work" or "with zeal for work" Neh 3:20.

B. Noun.

charon "burning anger." The 41 occurrences of this word cover every period of the Bible. This word refers exclusively to divine anger as that which is "burning." **Charon** first appears in Ex 32:12: "Turn from thy fierce wrath [**charon**], and repent of this evil against thy people."

NOSE

anap "to be angry." This verb, which has cognates in most of the Semitic languages, occurs 39 times in biblical Hebrew and in all periods. The verb appears in Isa 12:1: "O Lord, I will praise thee: though thou wast angry with me...."

TO PROVOKE (ANGER)

ka^oas, "to provoke, vex, make angry." This word is common throughout the history of Hebrew and is used in modern Hebrew in the sense of "to be angry, to rage." It occurs some 55 times in the Hebrew Old Testament.

A word that is characteristic of the Book of Deuteronomy, it seems fitting that **ka^oas** is found for the first time in the Old Testament in that book: "...to provoke him to anger" Deut 4:25. The word is characteristic also of the books of Jeremiah and Kings. A review of the uses of this verb shows that around 80 percent of them involve Yahweh's "being provoked to anger" by Israel's sin, especially its worship of other gods. One such example is in II Kings 23:19: "And all the houses also of the high places that were in the cities of Samaria, which the kings of Israel had made to provoke the Lord to anger, Josiah took away...."

TO BE WROTH, ANGRY

A. Verb.

qatsap "to be wroth, angry." This verb appears 34 times and is found mainly in the Pentateuch and in the prophets, and a few times in the historical books and the poetic literature. The word is used in rabbinic Hebrew, but its use in modern Hebrew has been displaced by other verbs. It is an ancient Canaanite word; as a gloss it appeared in the Amarna Tablets with the meaning "to become worried," or according to others, "to be embittered." The relation with the Arabic cognate *qasafa* is doubtful.

The general meaning of **qatsap** is a strong emotional outburst of anger, especially when man is the subject of the reaction. The first usage of the word brings this out: "And Pharaoh was wroth against two of his officers... and he put them in [custody]..." Gen 40:2-3; cf. 41:10. Moses became bitterly angry with the disobedient Israelites Ex 16:20. The leaders of the Philistines "were wroth" with Achish 1 Sam 29:4, and Naaman was strongly irritated by Elisha's lack of a sense of protocol II Kings 5:11. Elisha expressed his anger with Joash, king of Israel II Kings 13:19. King Ahasuerus deposed Vashti in his anger Est 1:12. In these examples an exalted person (generally a king) demonstrated his royal anger in radical measures against his subjects. He was in a position "to be angered" by the response of his subjects. It is rarer for a person "to become angry" with an equal. It is even rarer for a subject "to be angry" with his superior: "...two of the king's chamberlains... were wroth, and sought to lay hand on the king Ahasuerus" Est 2:21.

WROTH

The noun derived from **qatsap** particularly refers to God's anger. The verb **qatsap** is used 11 times to describe man's anger and 18 times to refer to God's anger. This fact, coupled with the observation that the verb generally is an expression of a superior against a subject, explains why the biblical text more frequently uses **qatsap** to describe God's anger. The object of the anger is often indicated by the preposition **±al** ("against"). "For I was afraid of the anger [**±ap**] and hot displeasure [**chemah**], wherewith the Lord was wroth [**qatsap**] against [**°al**] you to destroy you" Deut 9:19. The Lord's anger expresses itself against disobedience Lev 10:6 and sin Eccl 5:5ff. However, people themselves can be the cause for God's anger Ps 106:32. In the wilderness the Israelites provoked God to wrath by their disobedience and lack of faith: "Remember, and forget not, how thou provokedst the Lord thy God to wrath in the wilderness: from the day that thou didst depart out of the land of Egypt, until ye came unto this place, ye have been rebellious against the Lord" Deut 9:7; cf. vv. 8,22. Moses spoke about God's wrath against Israel's disobedience which would in time be the occasion for the Exile Deut 29:27, and the prophets amplify Moses' warning of God's coming "wrath" Jer 21:5. After the Exile,

God had compassion on Israel and turned His anger against Israel's enemies Isa 34:2.

In the Greek version we find the following translations: **orgizomai** ("to be angry") and **lupew** ("to grieve, to pain, to be sad").

WROTH

B. Noun.

qetsep "wrath." This noun occurs 28 times in biblical Hebrew and generally with reference to God. One occurrence of God's "wrath" is in 2 Chron 29:8: "Wherefore the wrath of the Lord was upon Judah and Jerusalem..." An example of man's "wrath" appears in Est 1:18: "Likewise shall the ladies of Persia and Media say this day unto all the king's princes, which have heard of the deed of the queen. Thus shall there arise too much contempt and wrath" (cf. Eccl 5:17).

ANGER, ANGRY (TO BE)

A. Noun.

orge originally any "natural impulse, or desire, or disposition," came to signify "anger," as the strongest of all passions. It is used of the wrath of man, Eph 4:31; Col 3:8; 1 Tim 2:8; James 1:19-20; the displeasure of human governments, Rom 13:4-5; the sufferings of the Jews at the hands of the Gentiles, Luke 21:23; the terrors of the Law, Rom 4:15; "the anger" of the Lord Jesus, Mark 3:5; God's "anger" with Israel in the wilderness, in a quotation from the OT, Heb 3:11; 4:3; God's present "anger" with the Jews nationally, Rom 9:22; 1 Thess 2:16; His present "anger" with those who disobey the Lord Jesus in His gospel, John 3:36; God's purposes in judgment, Matt 3:7; Luke 3:7; Rom 1:18; 2:5,8; 3:5; 5:9; 12:19; Eph 2:3; 5:6; Col 3:6; 1 Thess 1:10; 5:9. See INDIGNATION, VENGEANCE, WRATH.

Notes: (1) **Thumos**, "wrath" (not translated "anger"), is to be distinguished from **orge**, in this respect, that **thumos** indicates a more agitated condition of the feelings, an outburst of wrath from inward indignation, while **orge** suggests a more settled or abiding condition of mind, frequently with a view to taking revenge. Orge is less sudden in its rise than **thumos**, but more lasting in its nature. **Thumos** expresses more the inward feeling, **orge** the more active emotion. **Thumos** may issue in revenge, though it does not necessarily include it. It is characteristic that it quickly blazes up and quickly subsides, though that is not necessarily implied in each case.

(2) **Parorgismos**, a strengthened form of **orge**, and used in Eph 4:26, RV margin, "provocation," points especially to that which provokes the wrath, and suggests a less continued state than No. (1). "The first keenness of the sense of provocation must not be cherished, though righteous resentment may remain" (Westcott). The preceding verb, **orgizo**, in this verse implies a just occasion for the feeling. This is confirmed by the fact that it is a quotation from Ps 4:4 (Sept.), where the Hebrew word signifies to quiver with strong emotion.

ANGER

Thumos is found eighteen times in the NT, ten of which are in the Apocalypse, in seven of which the reference is to the wrath of God; so in Rom 2:8, RV, "wrath (**thumos**) and indignation" (**orge**); the order in the KJV is inaccurate. Everywhere else the word **thumos** is used in a bad sense. In Gal 5:20, it follows the word "jealousies," which when smoldering in the heart break out in wrath. **Thumos** and **orge** are coupled in two places in the Apocalypse, 16:19, "the fierceness (**thumos**) of

His wrath" (**orge**); and 19:15, "the fierceness of the wrath of Almighty God." See WROTH (be).

(3) **Aganaktesis** originally signified "physical pain or irritation" (probably from *agan*, "very much," and *achomai*, "to grieve"), hence, "annoyance, vexation," and is used in 2 Cor 7:11, "indignation."

B. Verbs.

1. orgizo "to provoke, to arouse to anger," is used in the middle voice in the eight places where it is found, and signifies "to be angry, wroth." It is said of individuals, in Matt 5:22; 18:34; 22:7; Luke 14:21; 15:28, and Eph 4:26 (where a possible meaning is "be ye angry with yourselves"); of nations, Rev 11:18; of Satan as the Dragon, 12:17 See WRATH.

2. parorgizo is "to arouse to wrath, provoke" (**para**, used intensively, and No. 1); Rom 10:19, "will I anger"; Eph 6:4, "provoke to wrath." See PROVOKE.

3. cholao connected with **chole**, "gall, bile," which became used metaphorically to signify bitter anger, means "to be enraged," John 7:23, "wroth," RV, in the Lord's remonstrance with the Jews on account of their indignation at His having made a man whole on the Sabbath Day.

Notes: (1) **Thumomacheo** (from **thumos**, "wrath," **machomai**, "to fight") originally denoted to fight with great animosity, and hence came to mean "to be very angry, to be exasperated," Acts 12:20, of the anger of Herod, "was highly displeased.

(2) **Thumoo**, the corresponding verb, signifies "to provoke to anger," but in the passive voice "to be wroth," as in Matt 2:16, of the wrath of Herod, "was exceeding wroth.

ANGER

(3) **Aganakteo**, see A, Note (3), is rendered in various ways in the seven places where it is used; "moved with indignation," Matt 20:24 and 21:15, RV (KJV, "sore displeased"); "had indignation," Matt 26:8; Mark 14:4. In Mark 10:14 the RV has "was moved with indignation" (KJV, "was much displeased"), said of the Lord Jesus. The same renderings are given in v. 41. In Luke 13:14 (KJV, "with indignation"), the RV rightly puts "being moved with indignation." These words more particularly point to the cause of the vexation. See DISPLEASE, INDIGNATION.

(4) In Col 3:21, **erethizo** signifies "to provoke." The RV correctly omits "to anger."

C. Adjective.

orgilos, "angry, prone to anger, irascible" (see B, Nos. 1, 2), is rendered "soon angry" in Titus 1:7.
