Hasty of Spirit

“A Crises in Defining Hasty”

It has become obvious that our perception of the English word hasty creates a massive false misunderstanding of the real meaning of the Biblical word hasty. We think hasty is to hurry (to do so for good or to be hasty for bad.) There is an old saying “haste makes waste.” Of the five (5) Hebrew words rendered hasty, one word is for urgent (it only shows up twice in the Bible). There is a Hebrew word for emotional excitement that makes an individual hurry; a Hebrew word for being hasty to make a decision prematurely; a Hebrew word to be impatient and hurry and a Hebrew word that reflects the true Hebrew definition of the word hasty. So if you could allow for all the above in the below definition then lets explore the full meaning. (Actually in this word hasty is a crisis that is wide spread in many people.)

Note in the following pages 7 progressive stages that can at the end get into a person’s spirit (body, soul, spirit)

Definition

It is to get to the place in life where one is absorbed (I almost used the word consumed) by having to obtain something (obsessed with success; and/ or control; and/or possessions.) It can be about a person, thing or objective. It creates a struggle with the fear of man (being a hindrance); the fear of loss; and the fear of failure. It is to be in and out of obsession. The end is to be a challenge to others as it shows up in wrath. When they are challenged in power, position or possessions wrath can show up. “All” of this is the “end” for a person who is hasty of spirit. It leads to bad decisions. To be around them is like walking on eggs at times. There are times they are OK and actually nice, but the problem part will return soon. They are hardly happy and can’t be satisfied.

10 Visible Signs

Be Careful: This list below can show up one at a time or all at once **in people who are not hasty**. However, if a person is hasty in spirit then all the below items are in the persons life. **Some of these are hardly visible yet some are obvious. Also, at various times some will be more obvious.**

1. They are quick to be negative of someone else.

Proverbs 1:16

For their feet run to evil, *and make haste* to shed blood.

2. They are quick to evil (4 parts in evil: pride, arrogance, manipulative way; and an unreasonable mouth).

Proverbs 6:18

An heart that deviseth wicked imaginations, feet *that be swift* in running to mischief,

3. They are reactionary. Quick to be uptight.

Proverbs 14:17

He that is *soon* angry dealeth foolishly: and a man of wicked devices is hated.

TO HASTEN, MAKE HASTE

mahar "to hasten, make haste." This verb and various derivatives are common to both ancient and modern Hebrew. **Mahar** occurs approximately 70 times in the Hebrew Bible; it appears twice in the first verse in which it is found: "And Abraham hastened into the tent unto Sarah, and said, Make ready quickly three measures of fine meal..." Gen 18:6. **Mahar** often has an adverbial use when it appears with another verb, such as in Gen 18:7: "...hasted to dress it" (or "quickly prepared it").
